Important Notes:

- **Don't forget to apply to graduate:** Students will also need to apply to graduate early during the semester they plan to graduate (i.e. apply in early March for May graduation; early June for August graduation; early September for December graduation). You can rollover your graduation to the next semester with the Graduate Rollover Application*. August graduates walk in December graduation.
- **A defended and revised thesis or dissertation is due over a month before the end of the semester:** Plan accordingly (i.e. late July for August graduation; late October for December graduation). You can rollover your graduation to the next semester with the Graduate Rollover Application. If you miss the deadline to submit the defended thesis/dissertation, as long as you submit the document by Early Deadline** and the graduate school shows that you have completed all of your requirements for the degree, you do not have to be enrolled for the semester your degree is conferred.

**Early Deadline Form (to be used when you miss the defended document submission deadline and need to enroll in another semester -required to be enrolled to graduate- but do not want to register/pay for classes)
