Presentation Support
Fall 2021 - Spring 2022
Program Guidelines**

Description

The Experiential Student Scholar Presentation Support financially supports students in partnering with a faculty or staff mentor to present findings from experiential projects at state, regional, national, and international academic forums related to their discipline.

A maximum of \$250 *per presentation* may be awarded.

Funding for the program is available on a first come, first serve basis.

Priority will be given to Undergraduate Experiential Student Scholars.

Eligibility

Student applicants must be undergraduate or graduate students currently enrolled at TWU at the time the application. A student may receive only one award per academic year from this program. The award may be used to support one student or a group of students provided that each student supported is presenting. The request for funding support must be supported by the student's faculty or staff mentor.

Successful Applications

- Are complete;
- As accurate as possible;
- Avoid using discipline-specific jargon
- Submitted at least three weeks in advance of conference

Review and Notification

Applications will be reviewed and applicants will be notified of the outcome and next steps as soon as possible after review.
