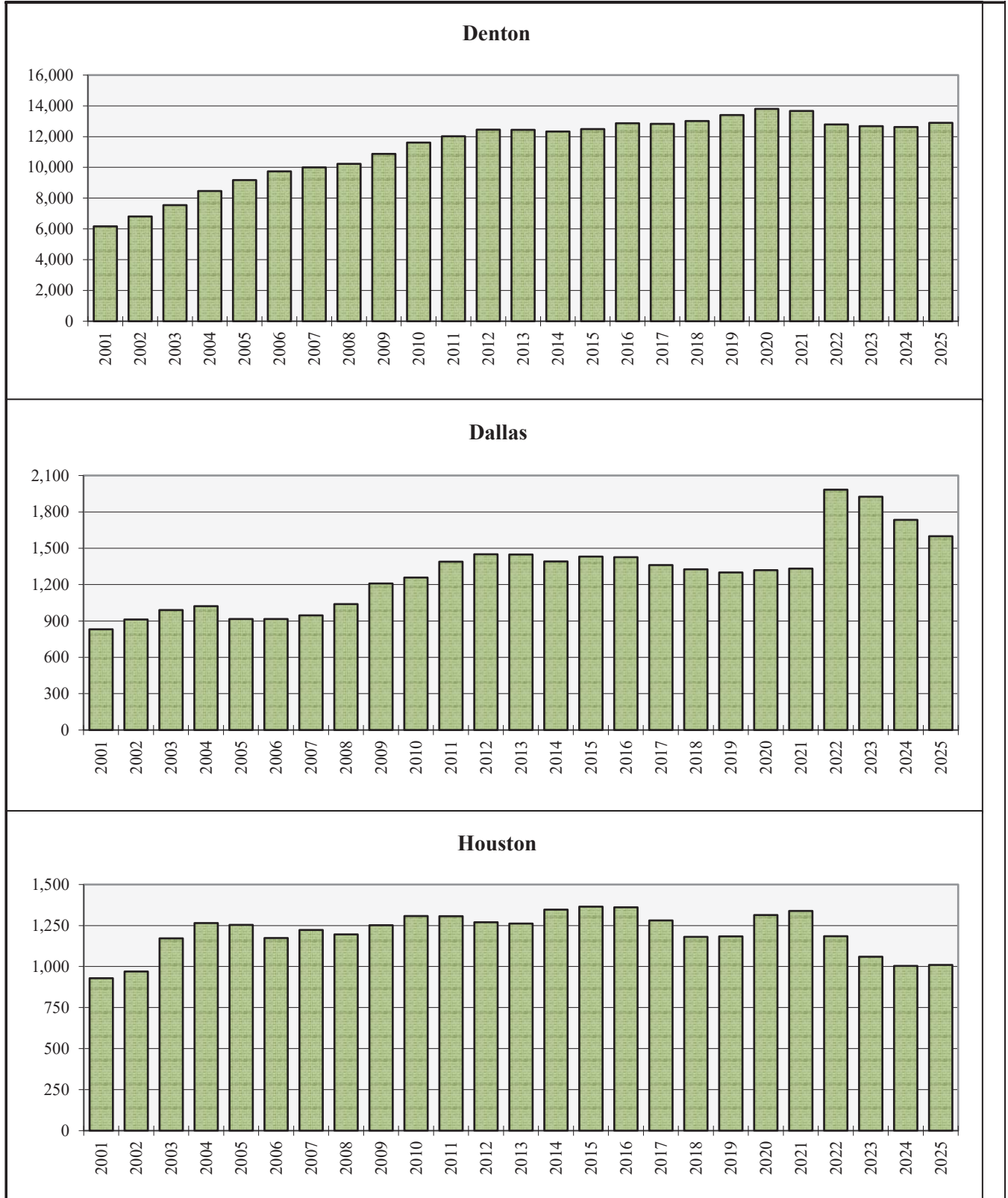

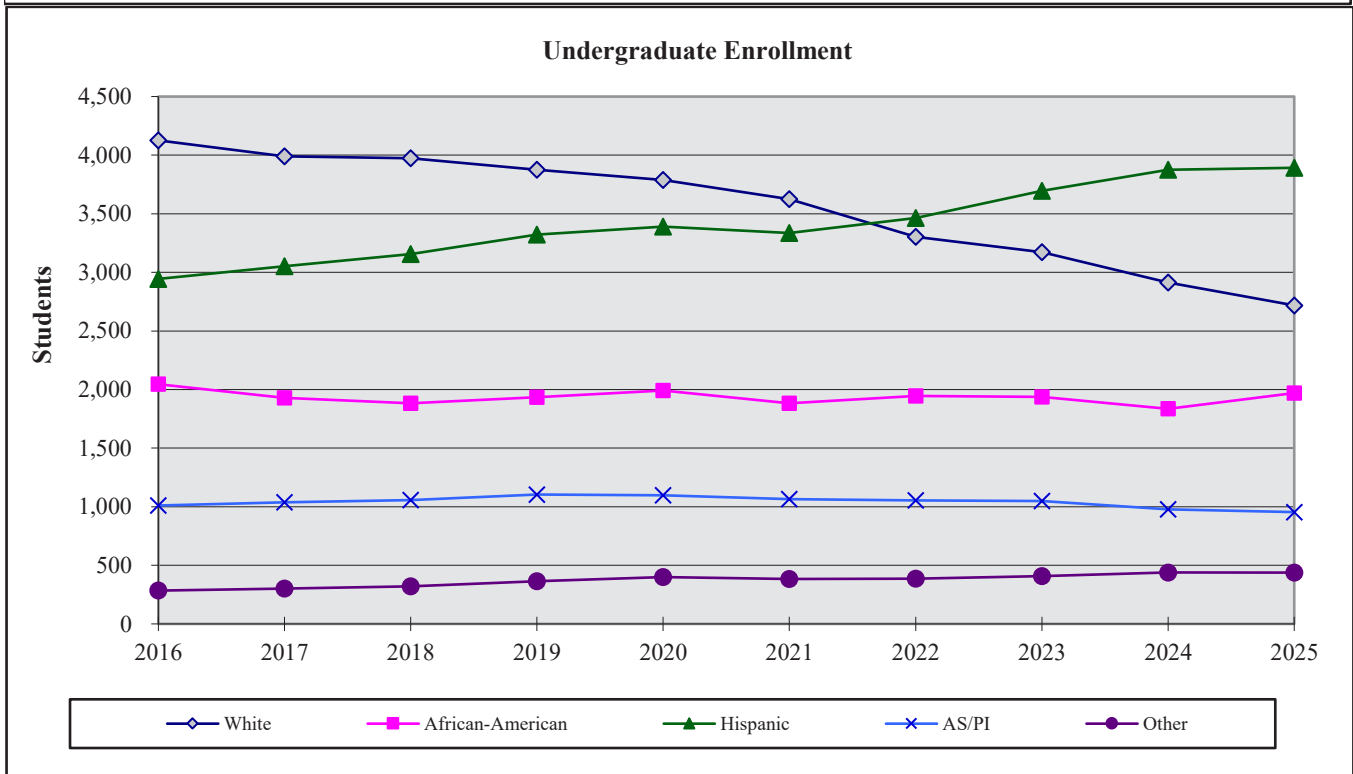
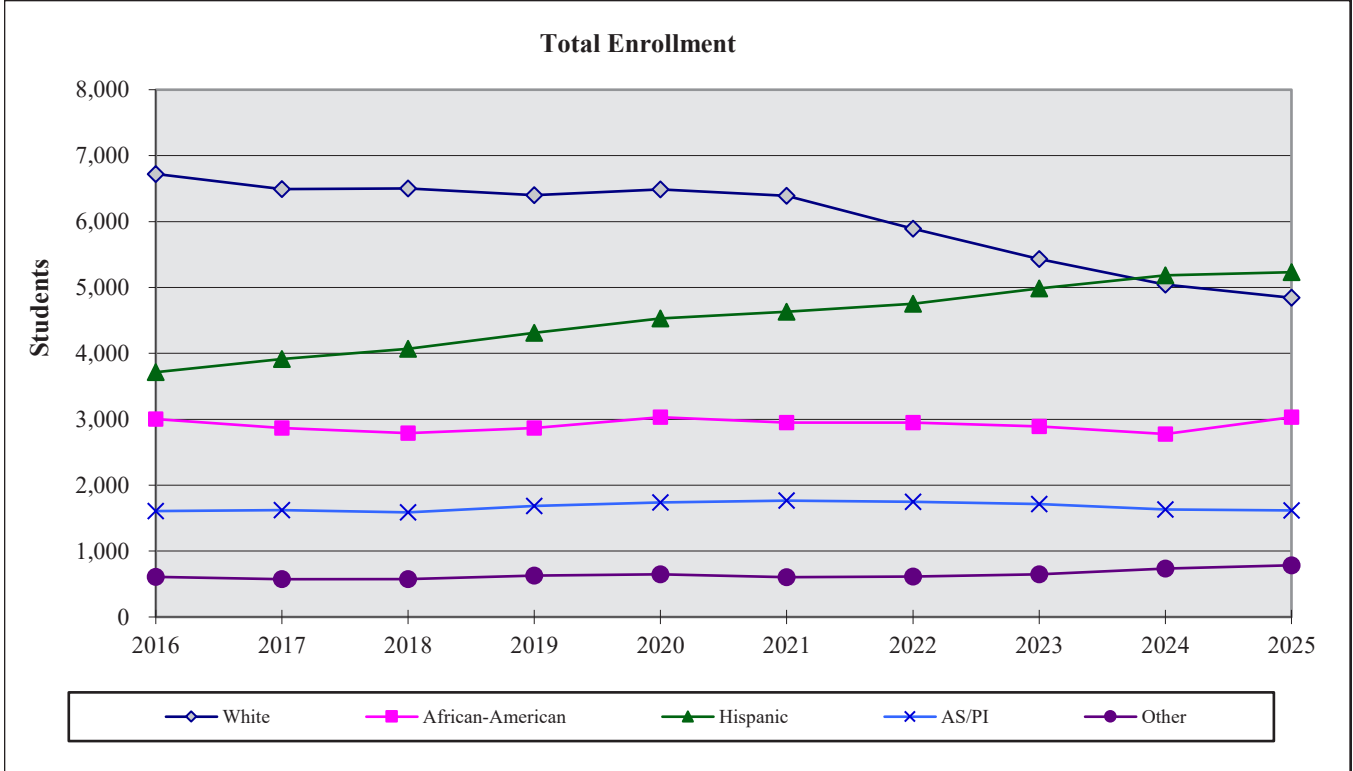

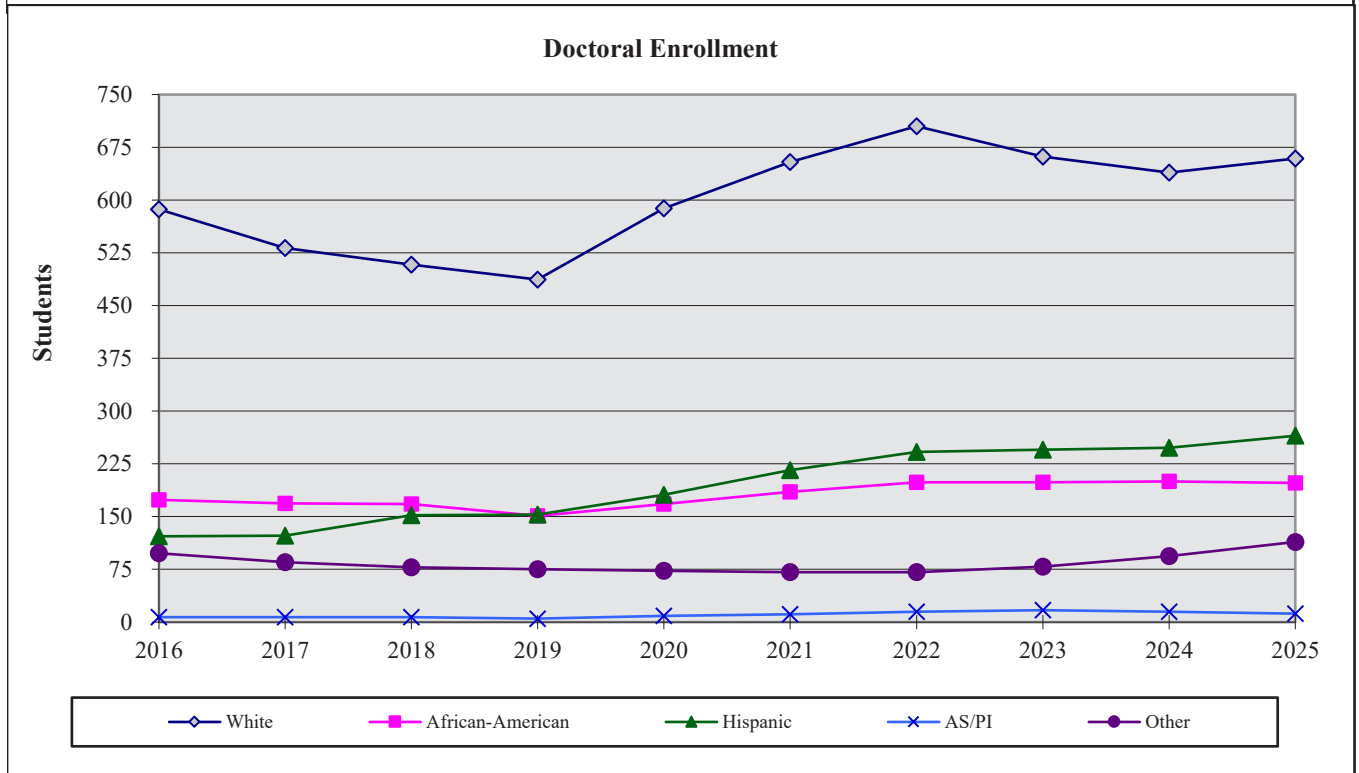
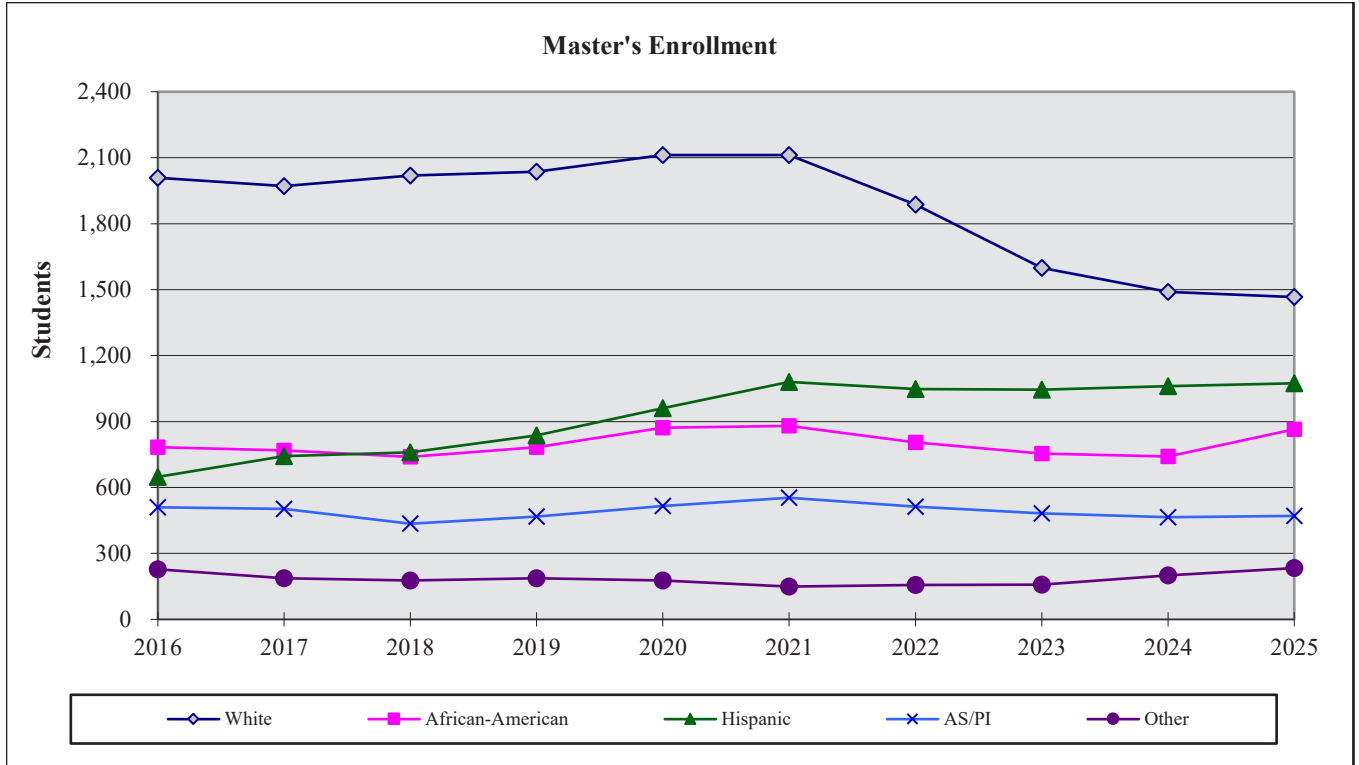

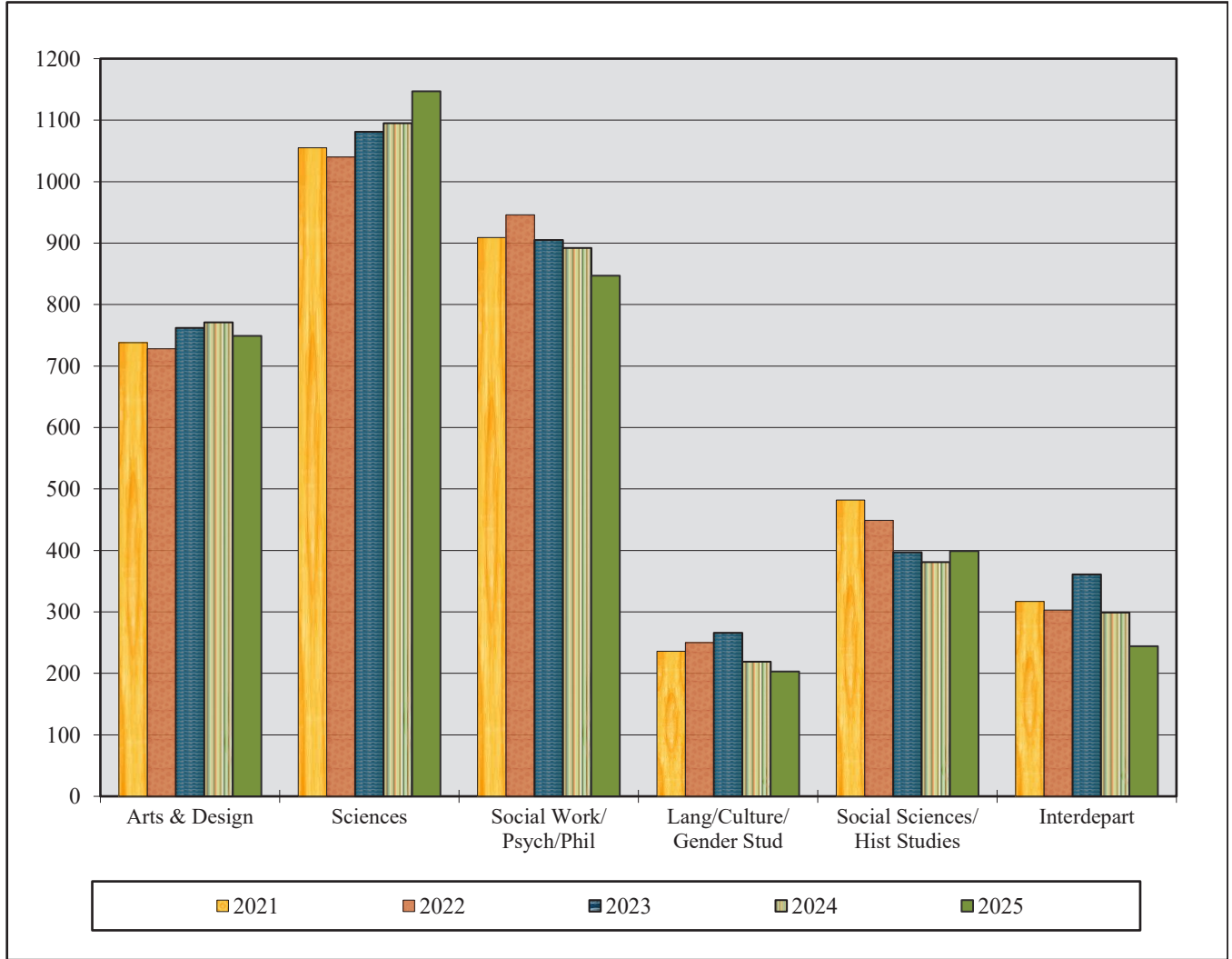

Fall Semesters, 2021 through 2025



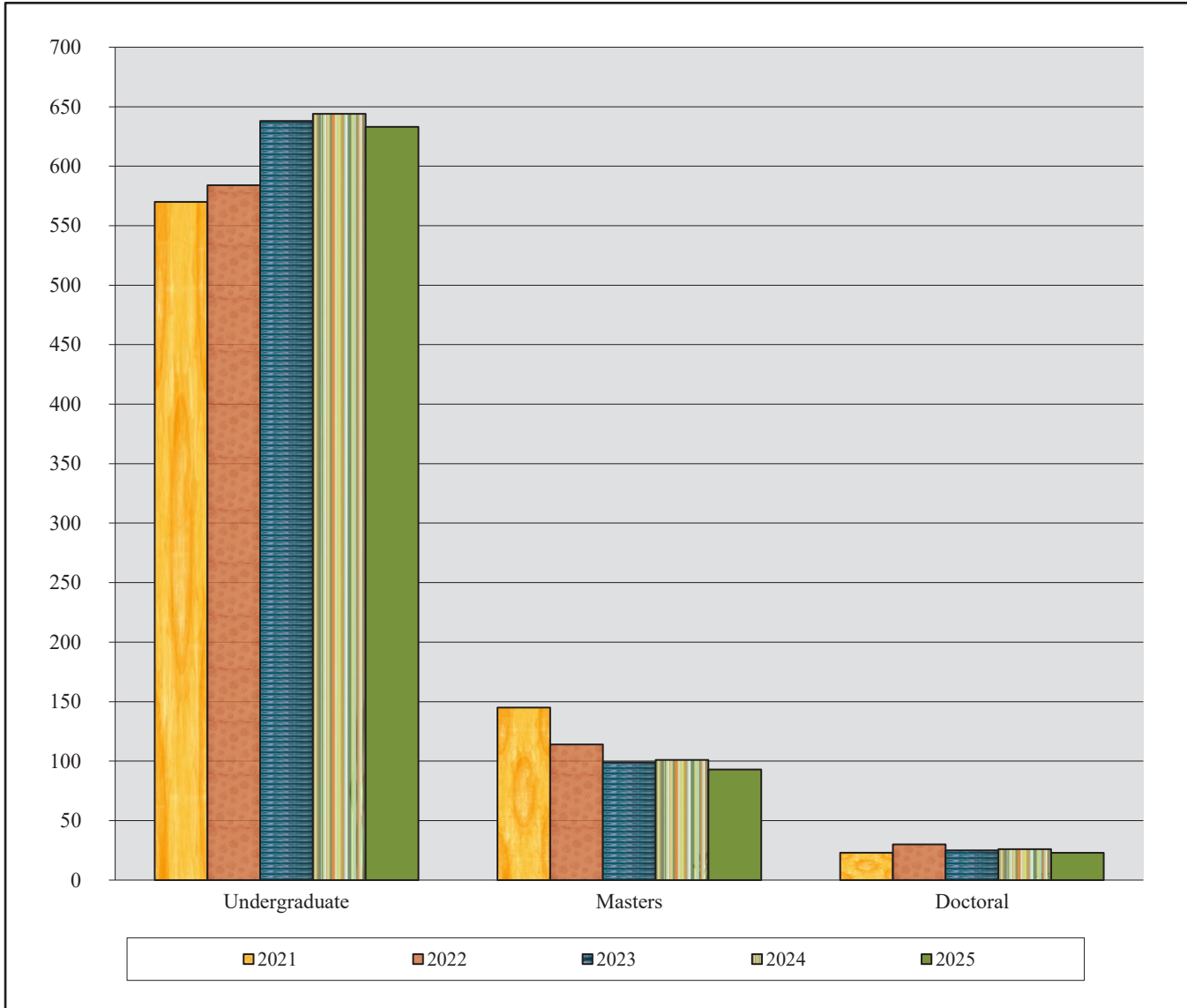

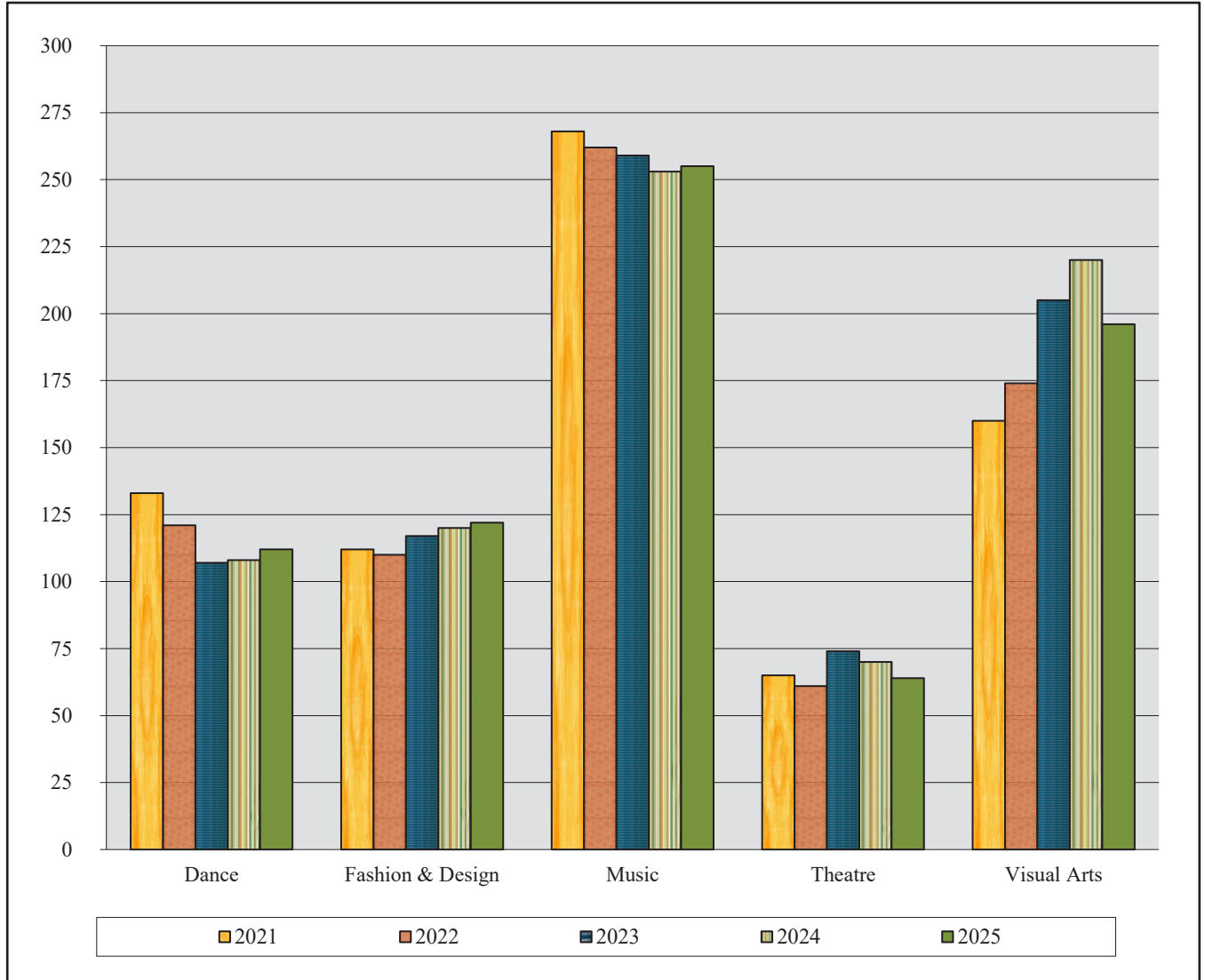

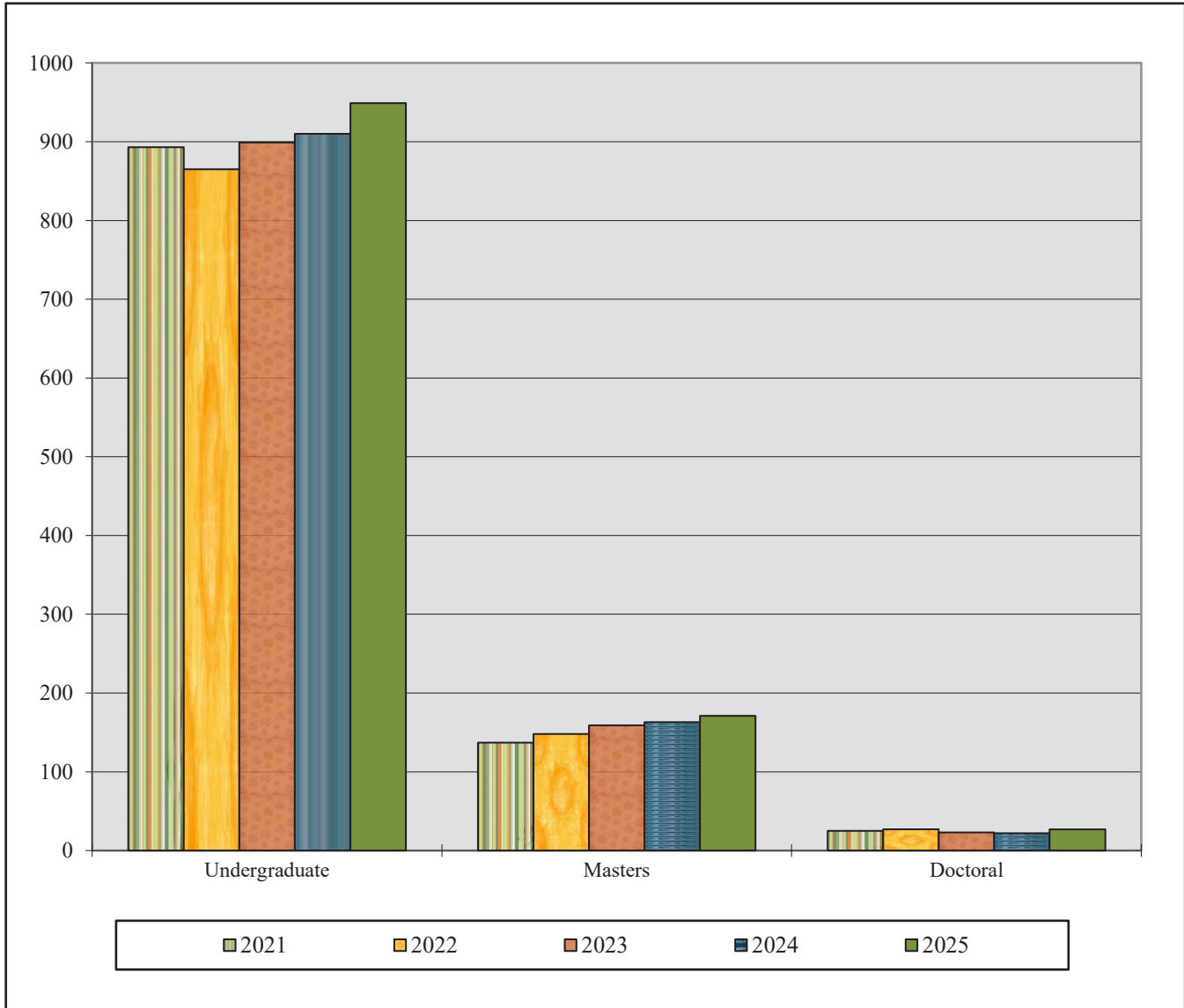

Fall Semesters, 2021 through 2025



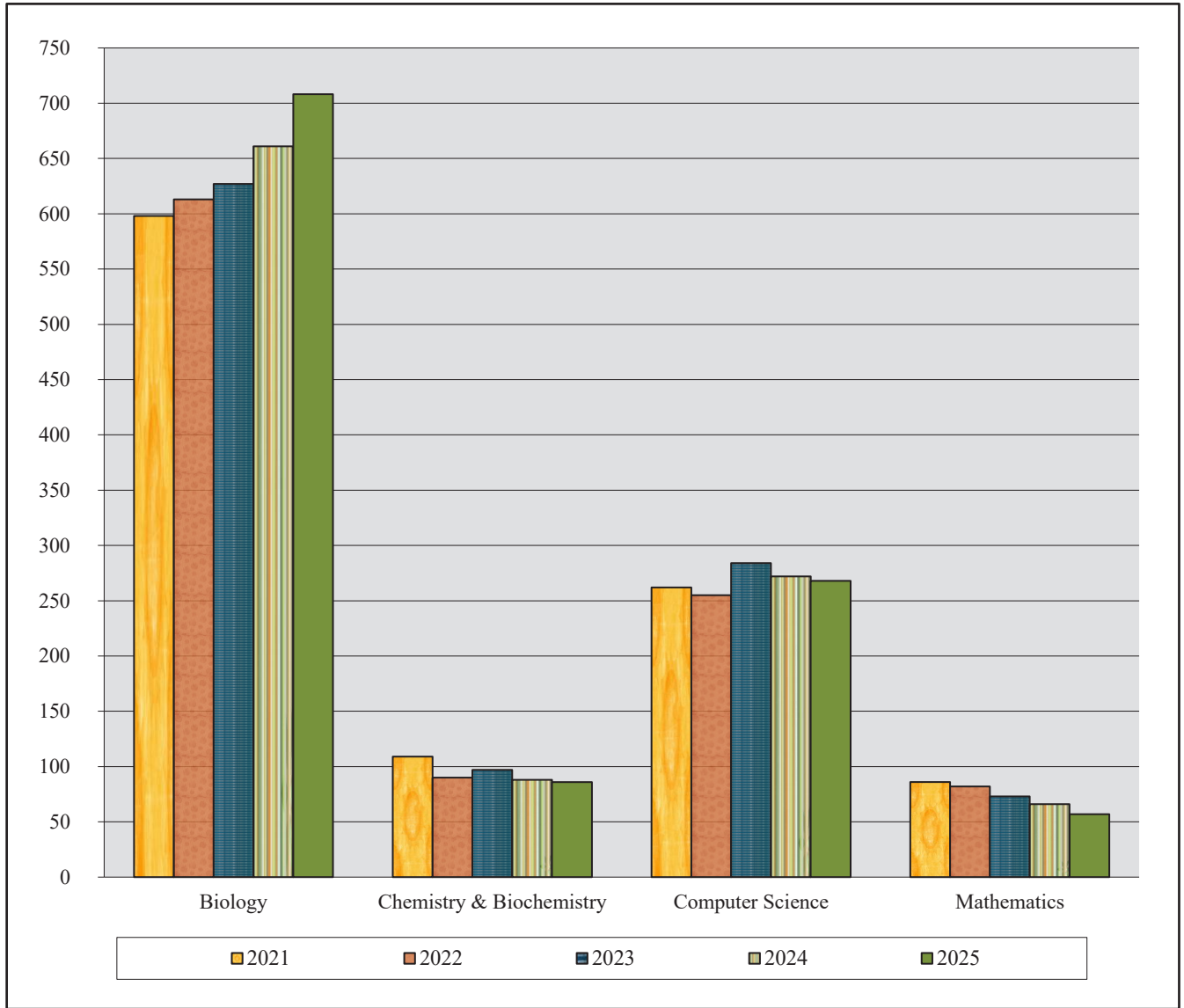

Fall Semesters, 2021 through 2025



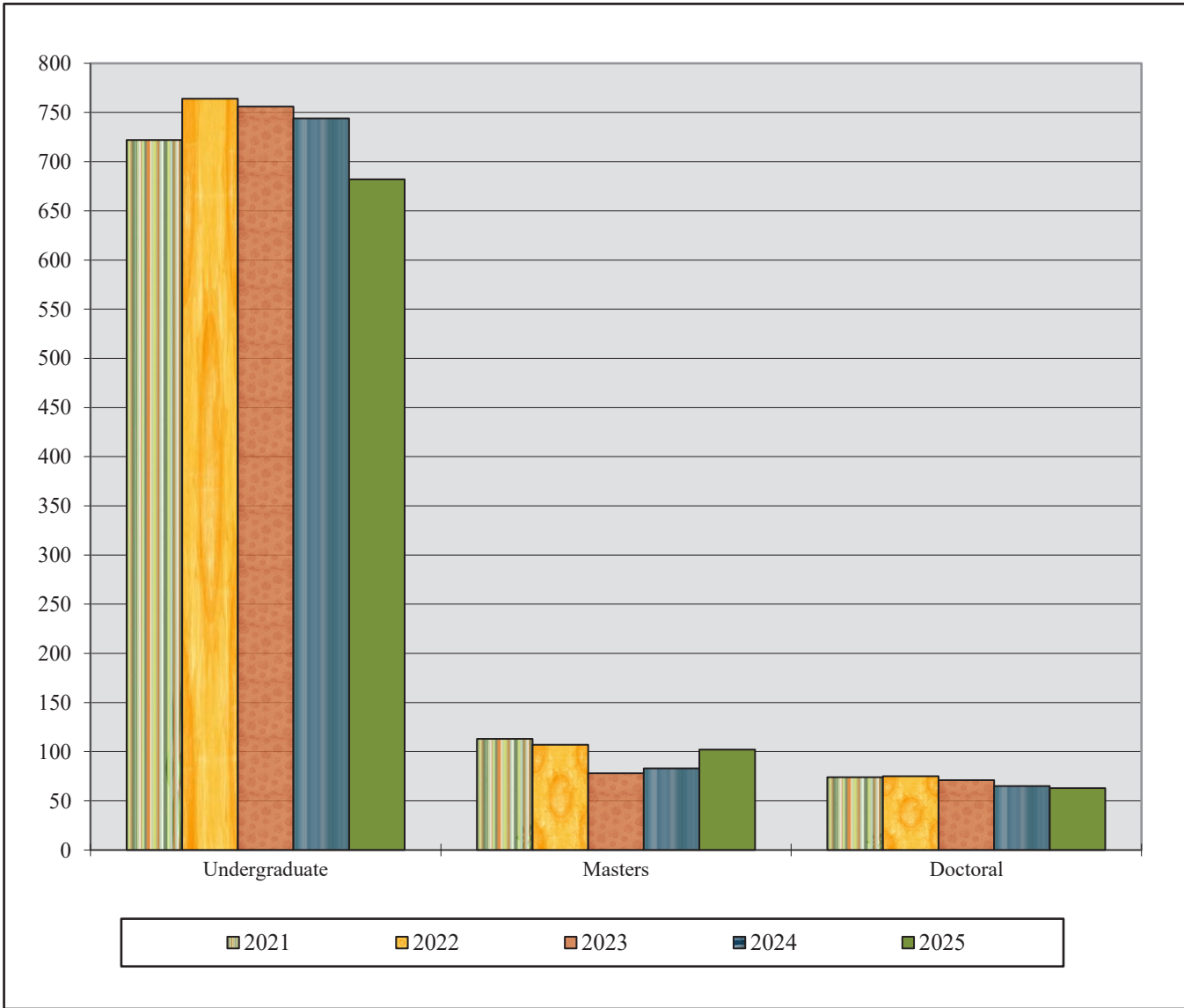

Fall Semesters, 2021 through 2025



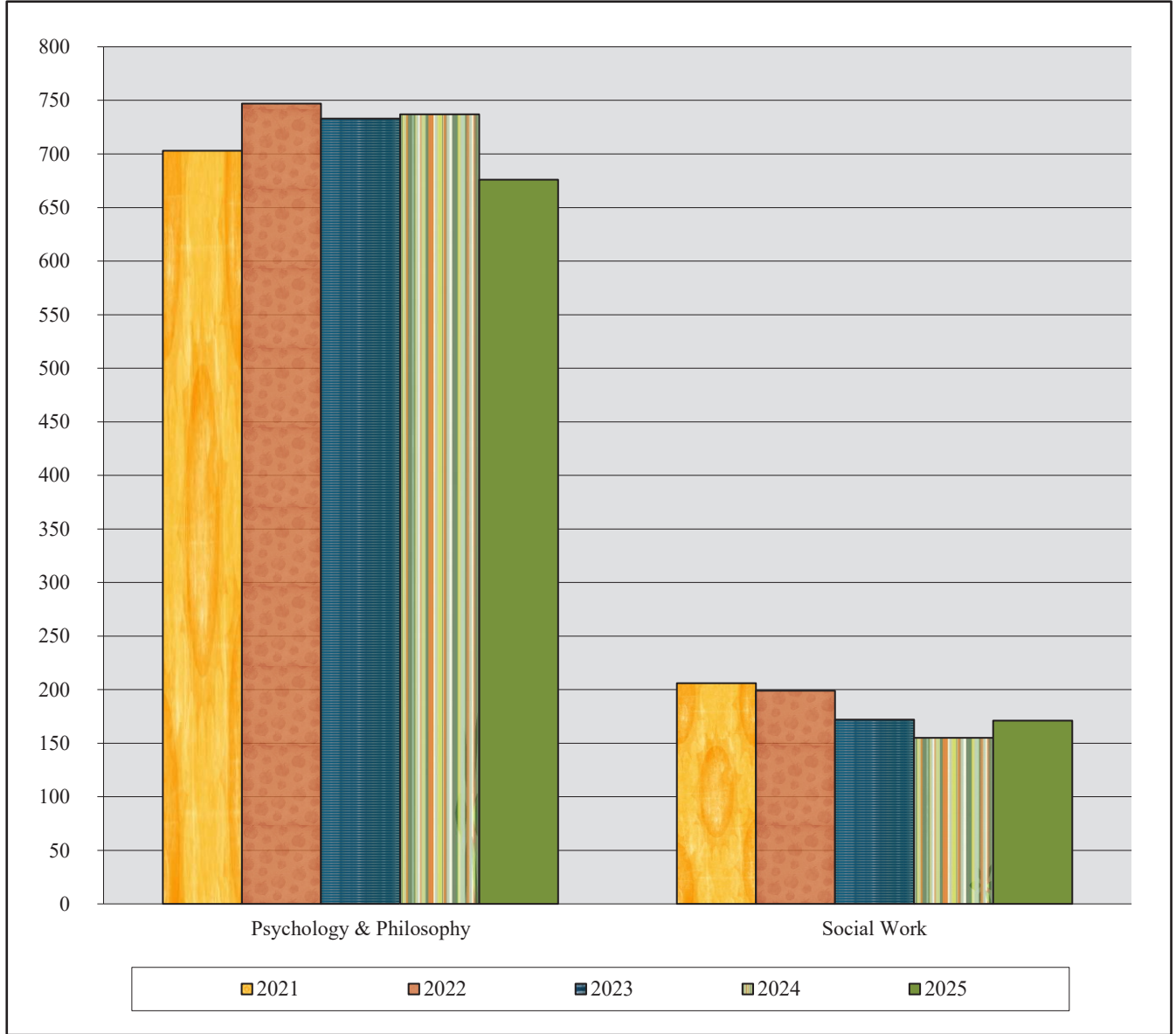

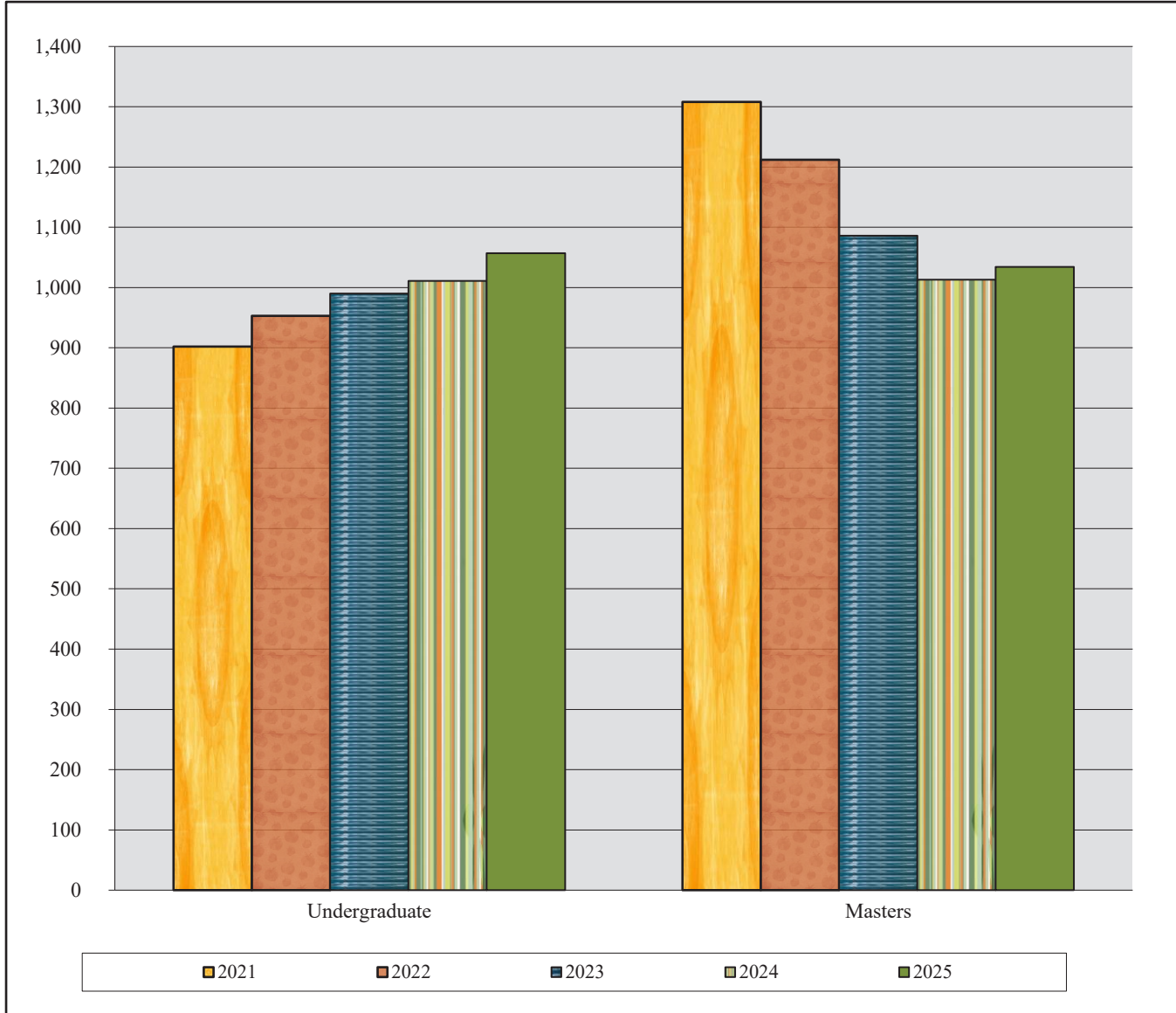

Fall Semesters, 2021 through 2025



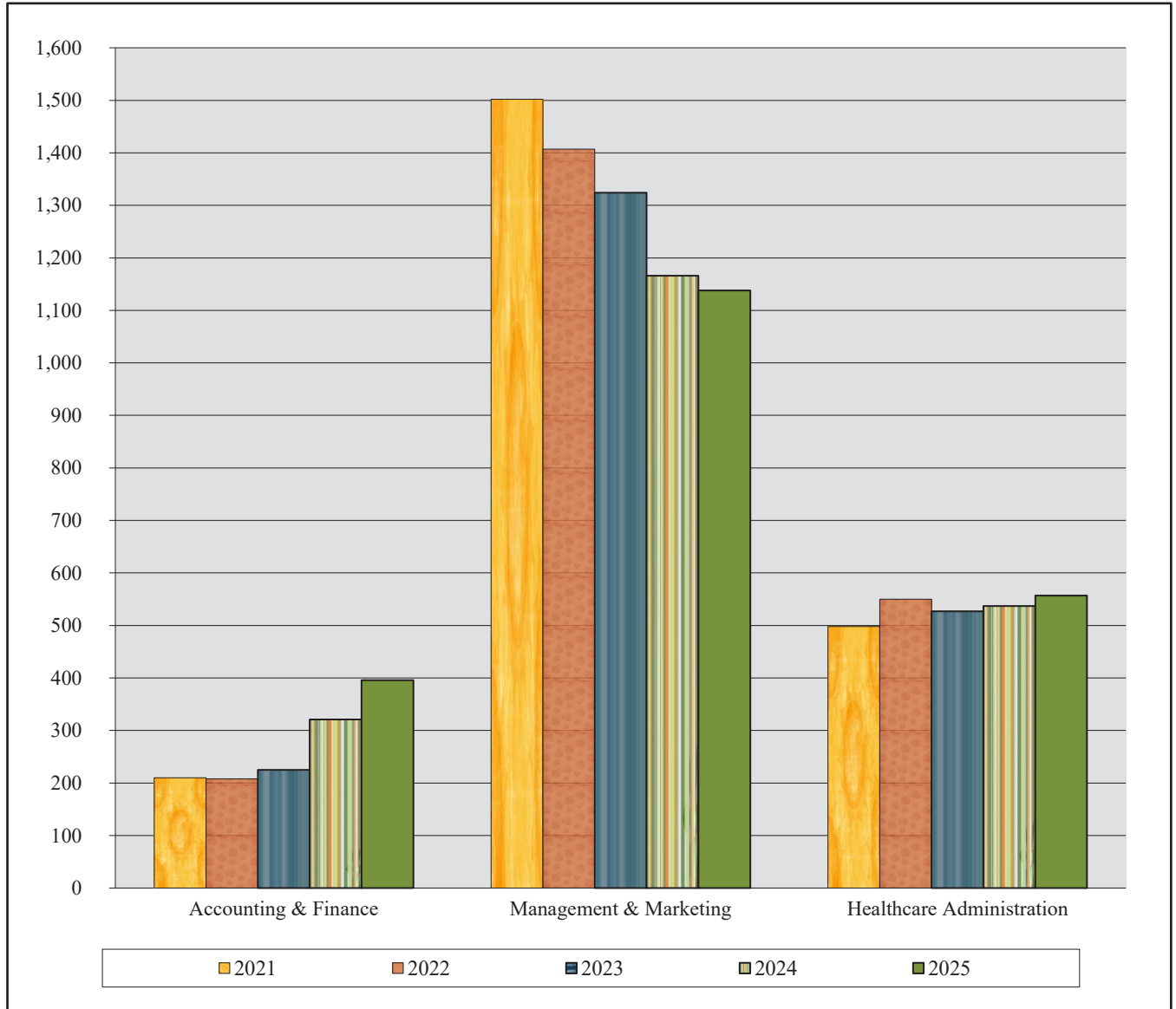

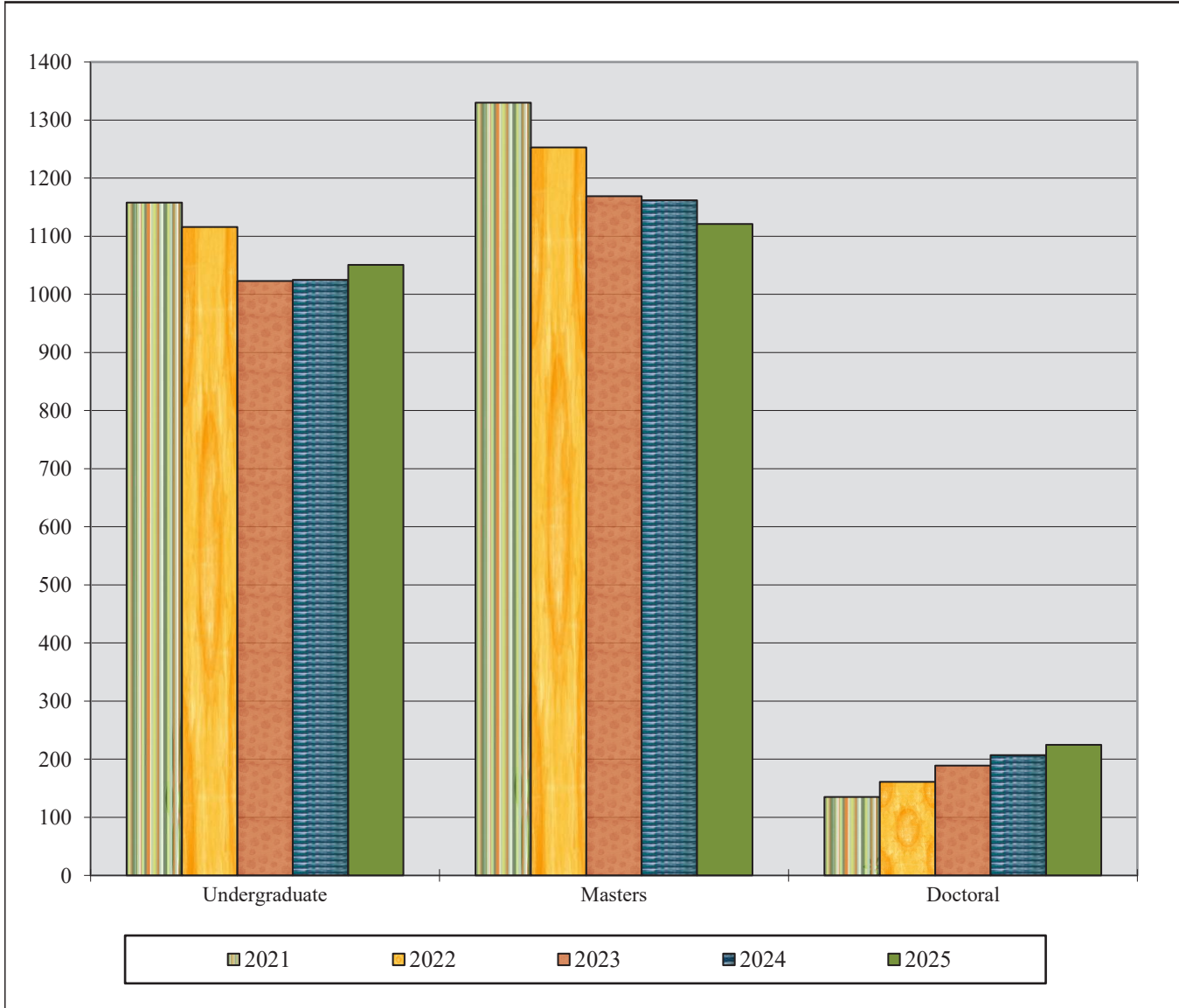

Fall Semesters, 2021 through 2025



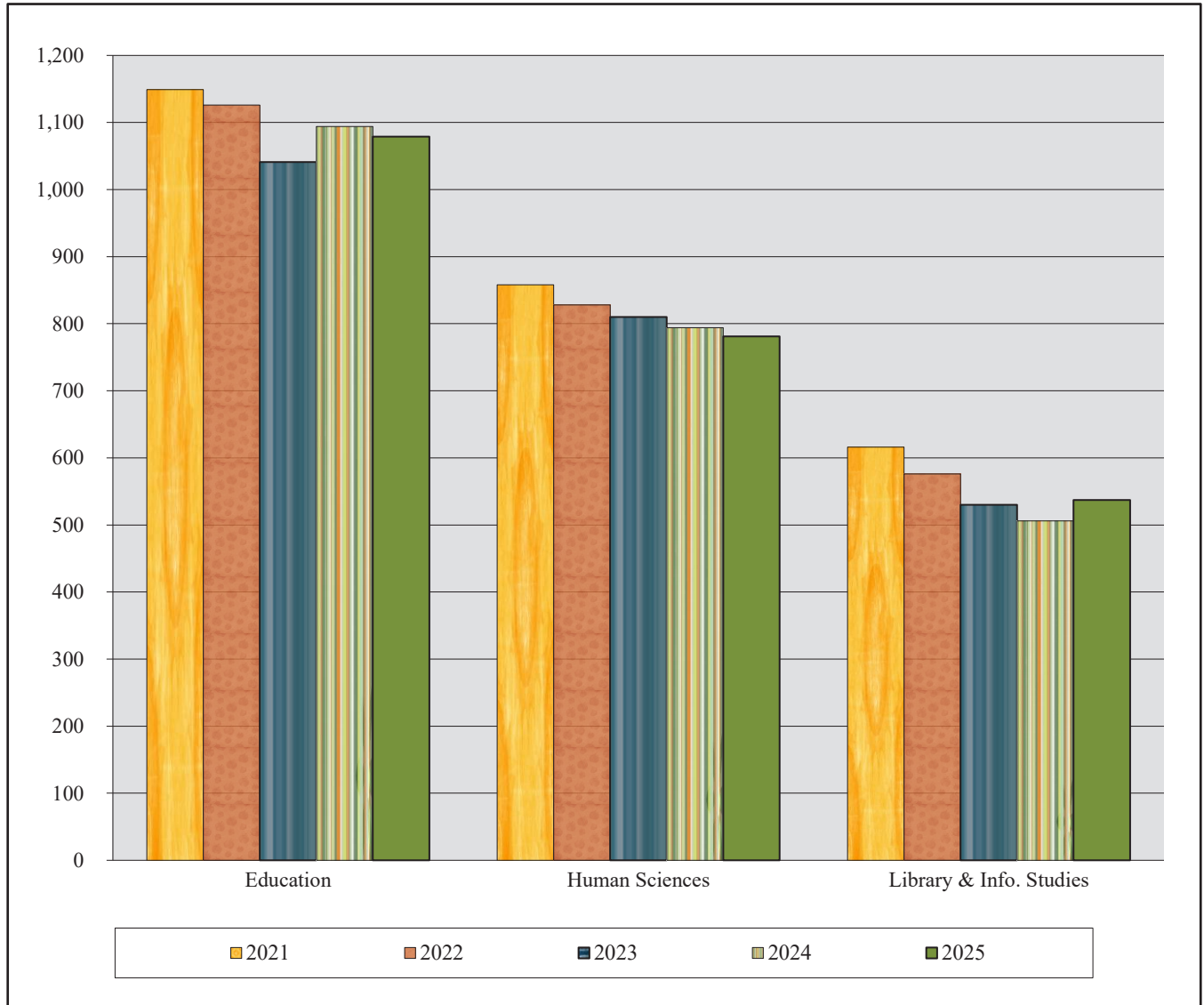

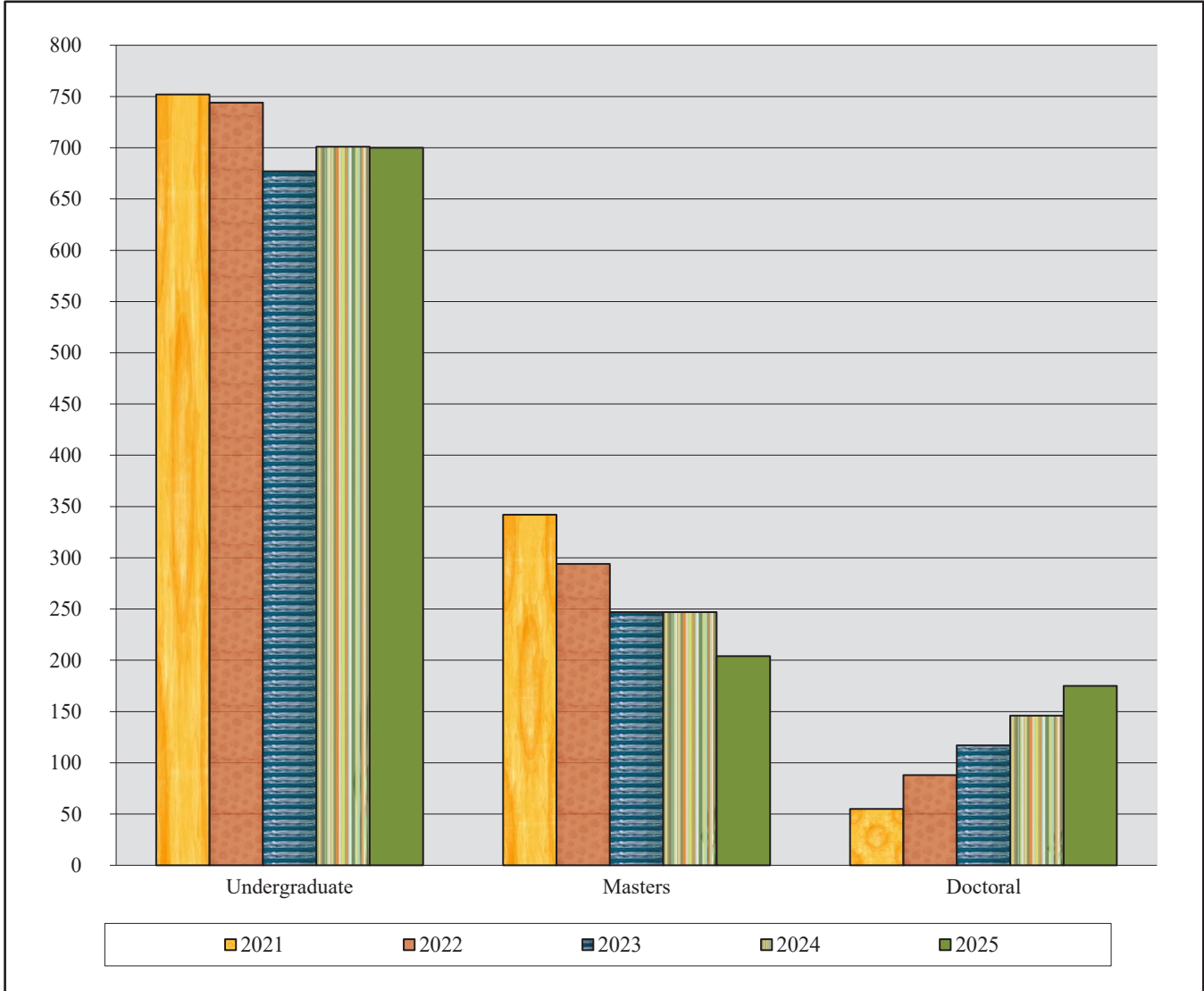

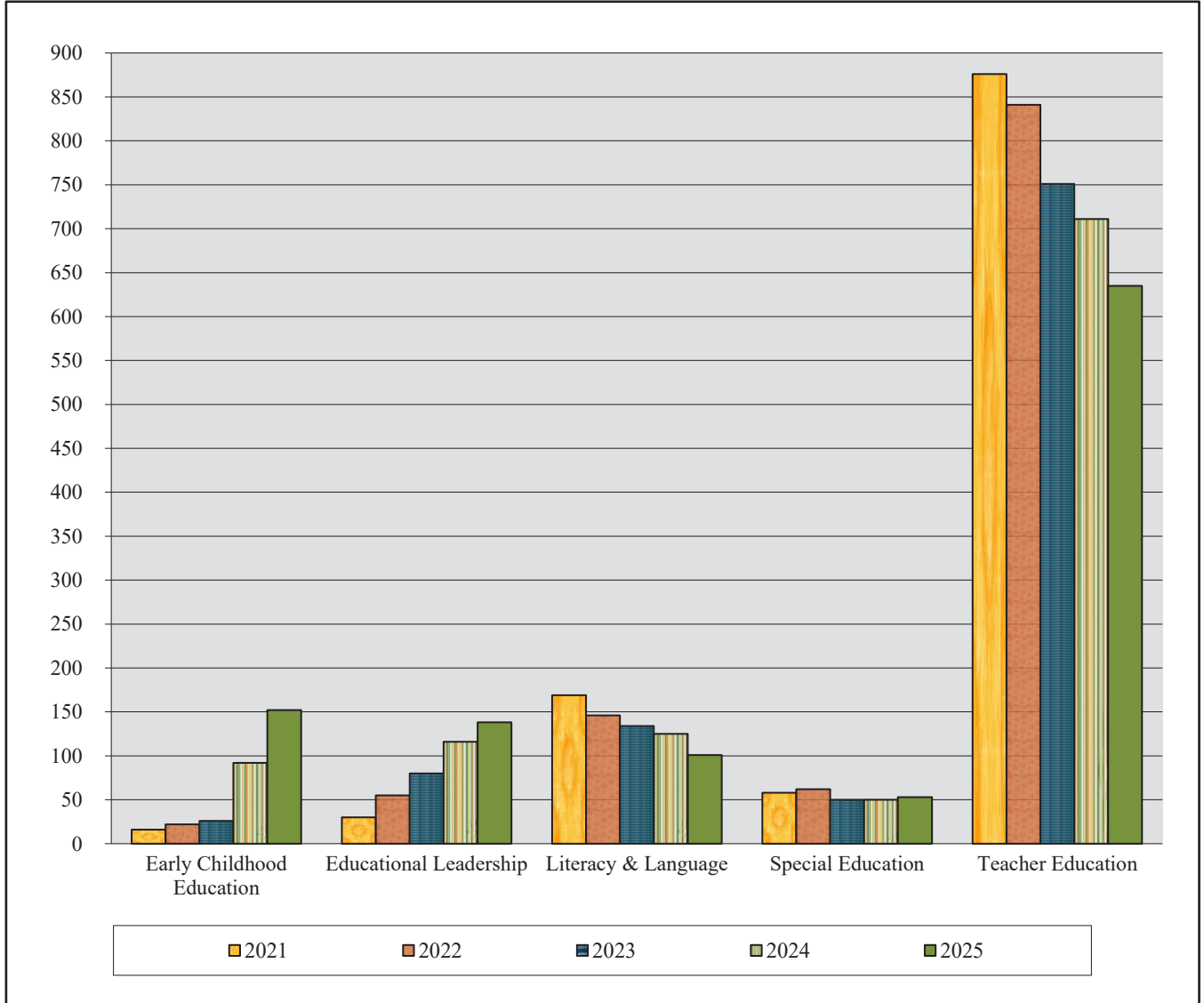

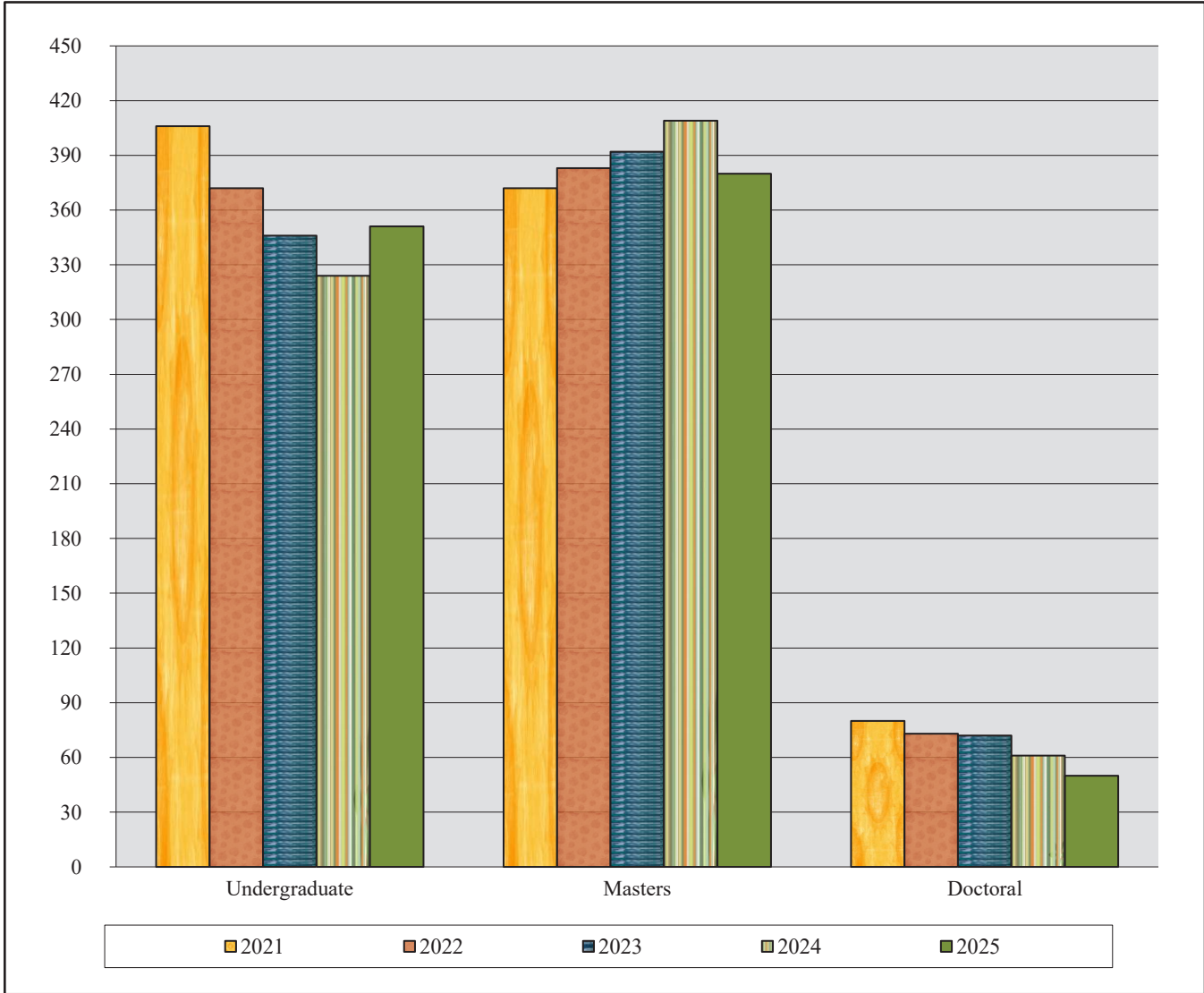

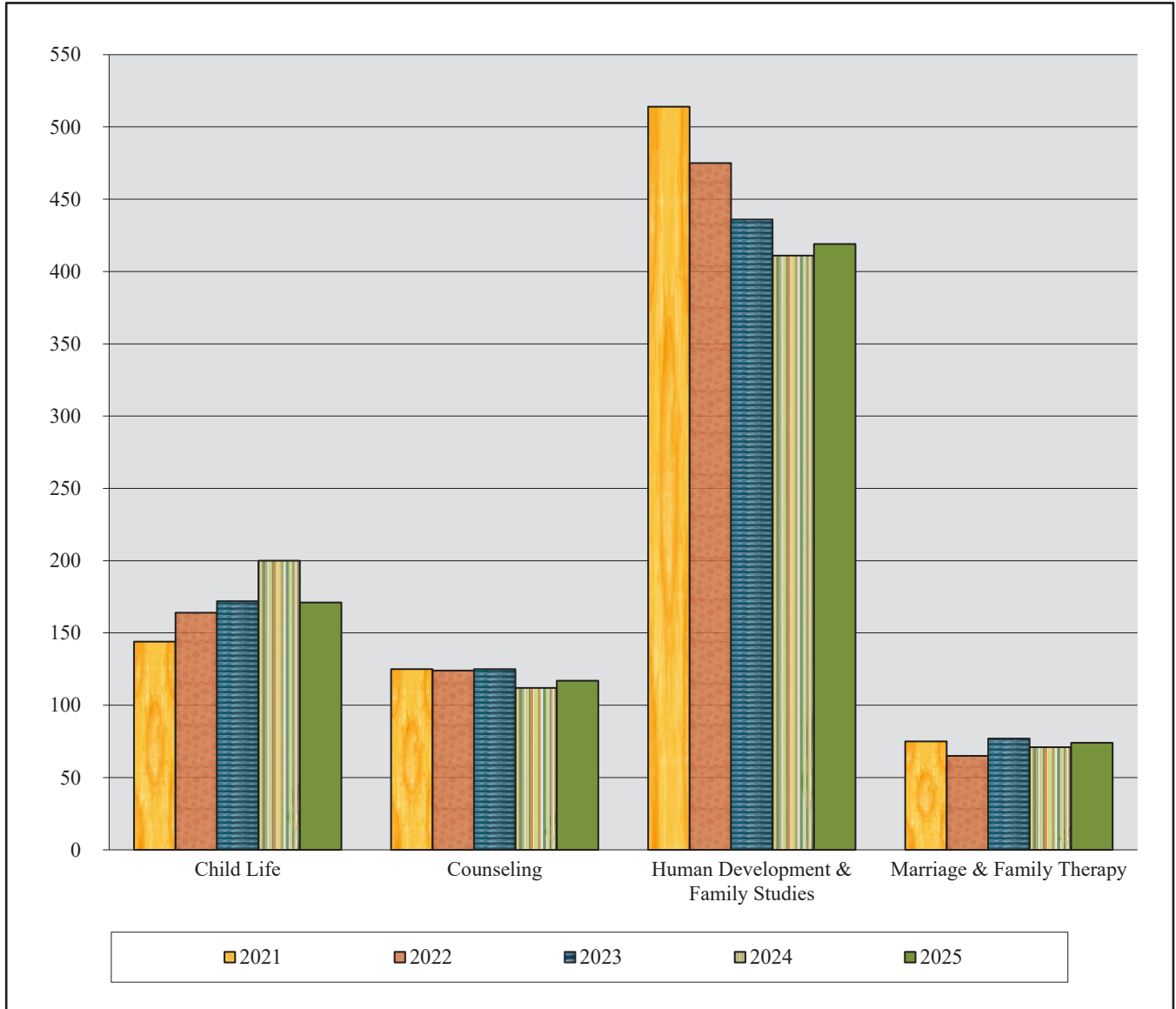

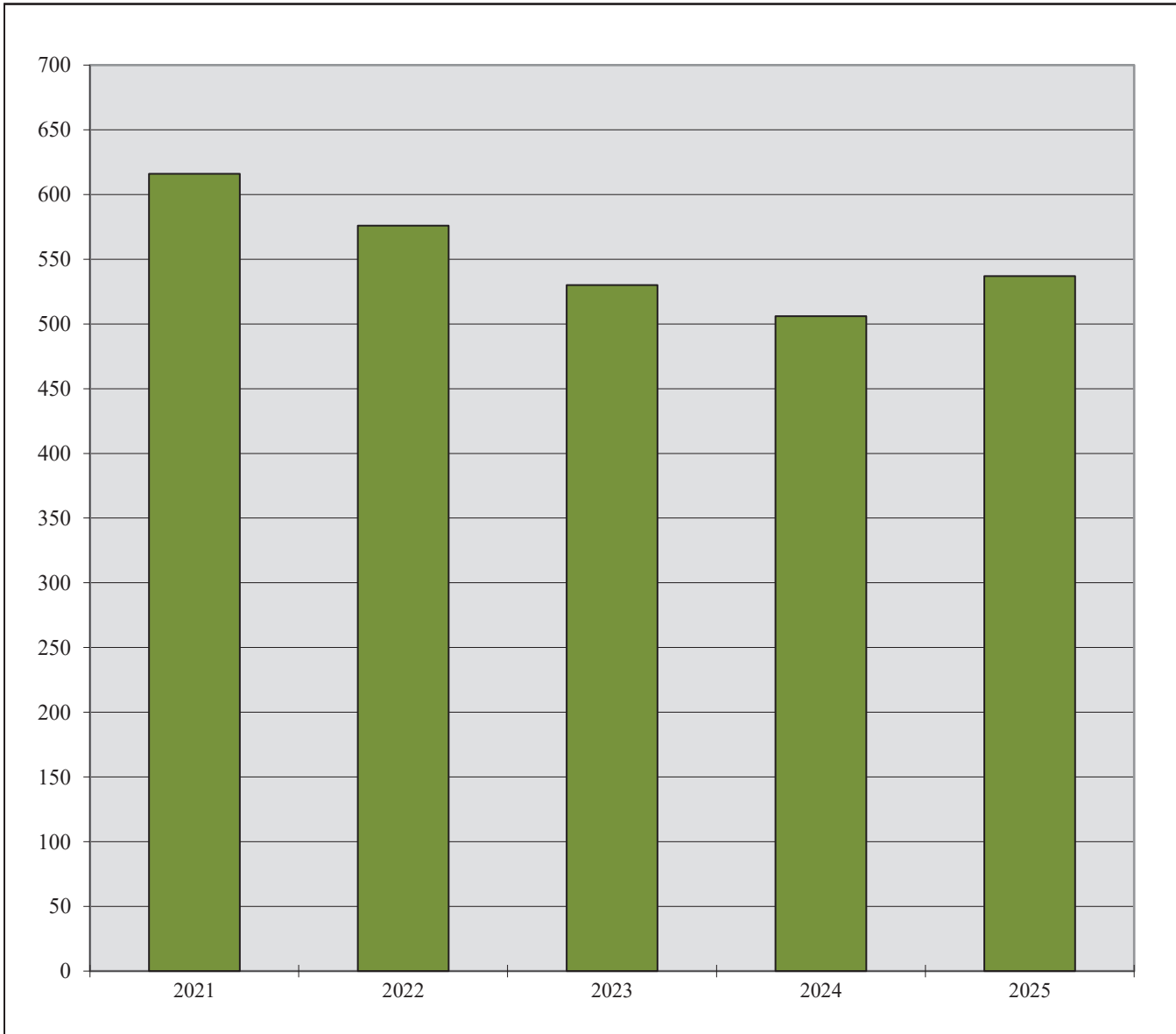

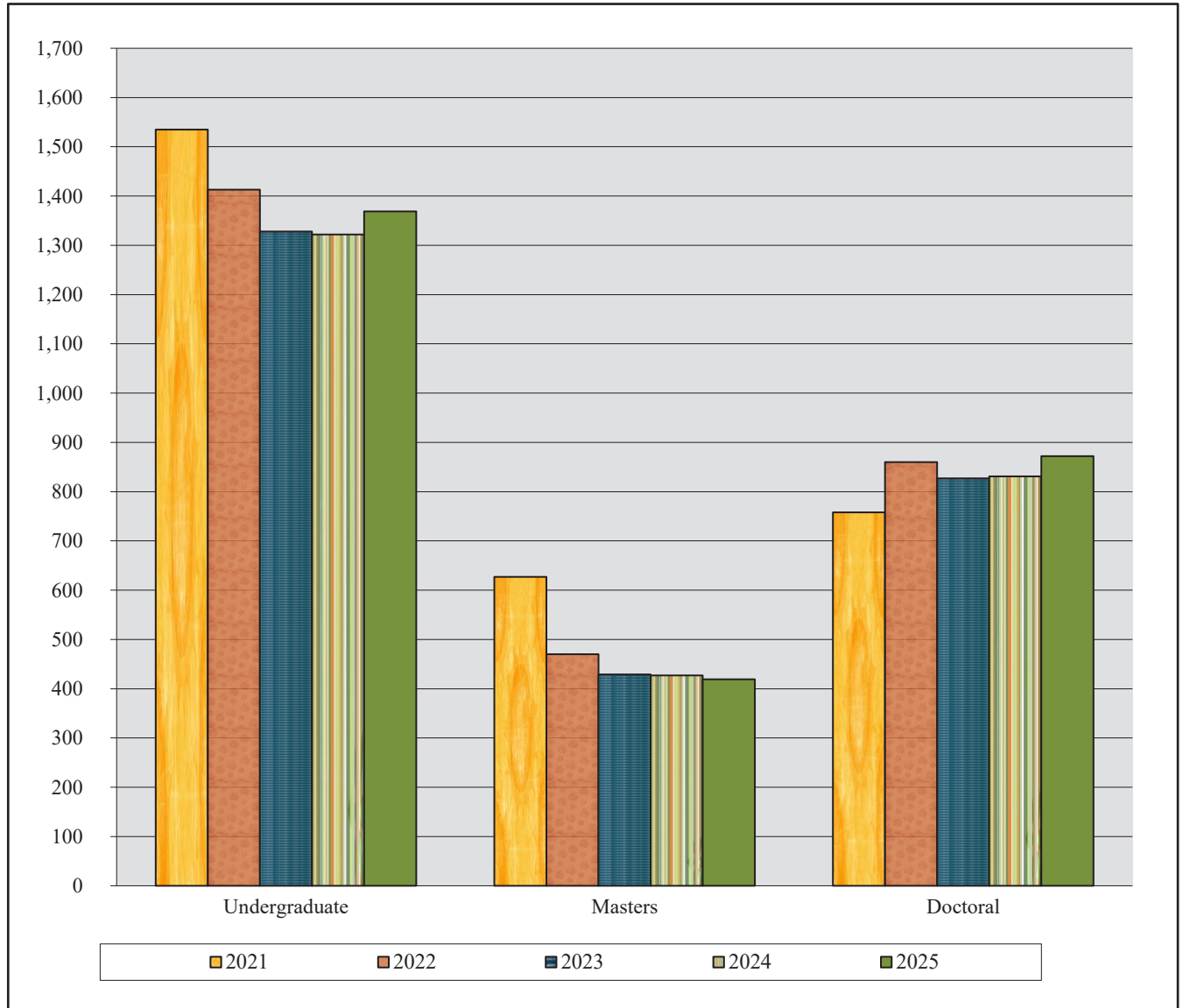

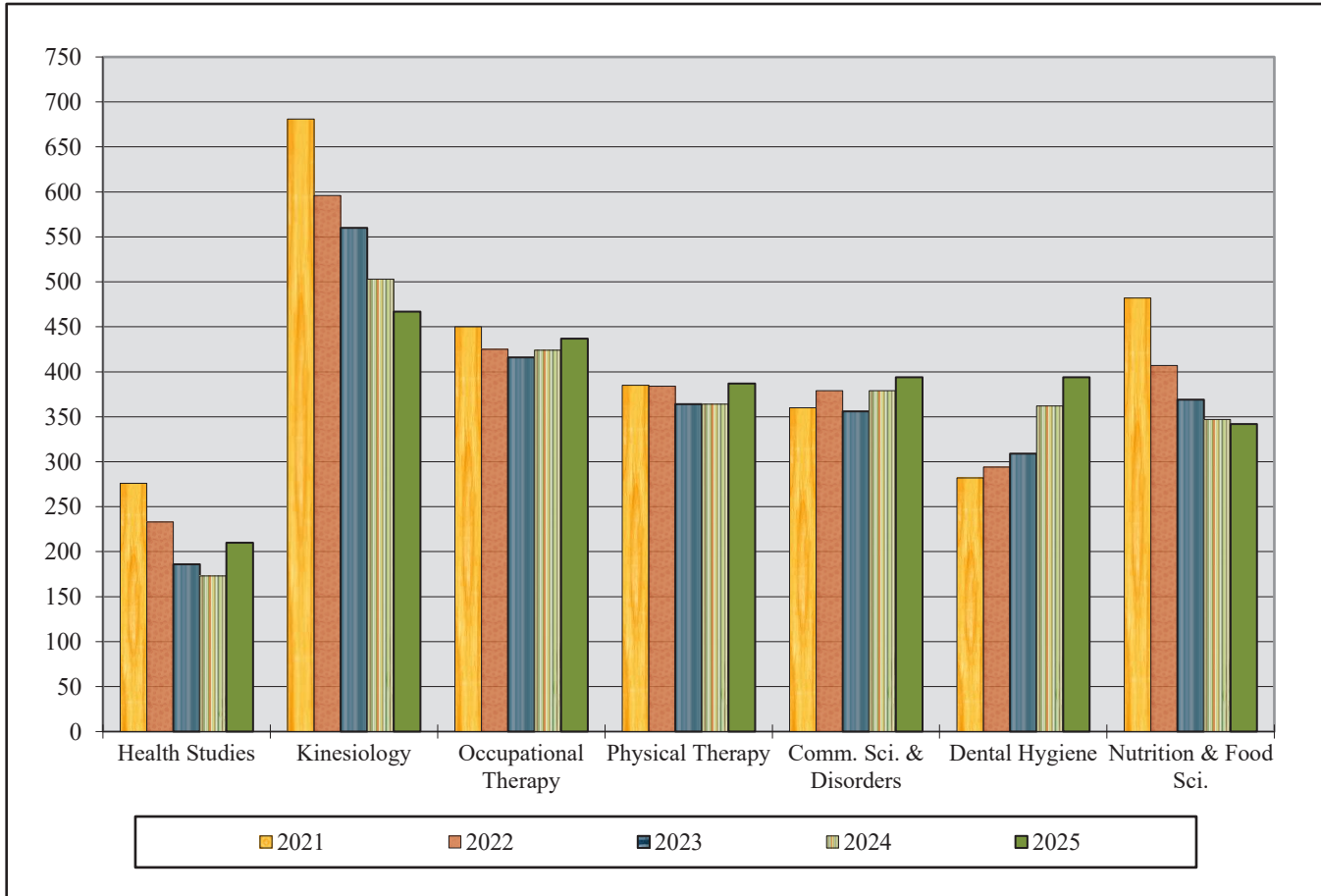

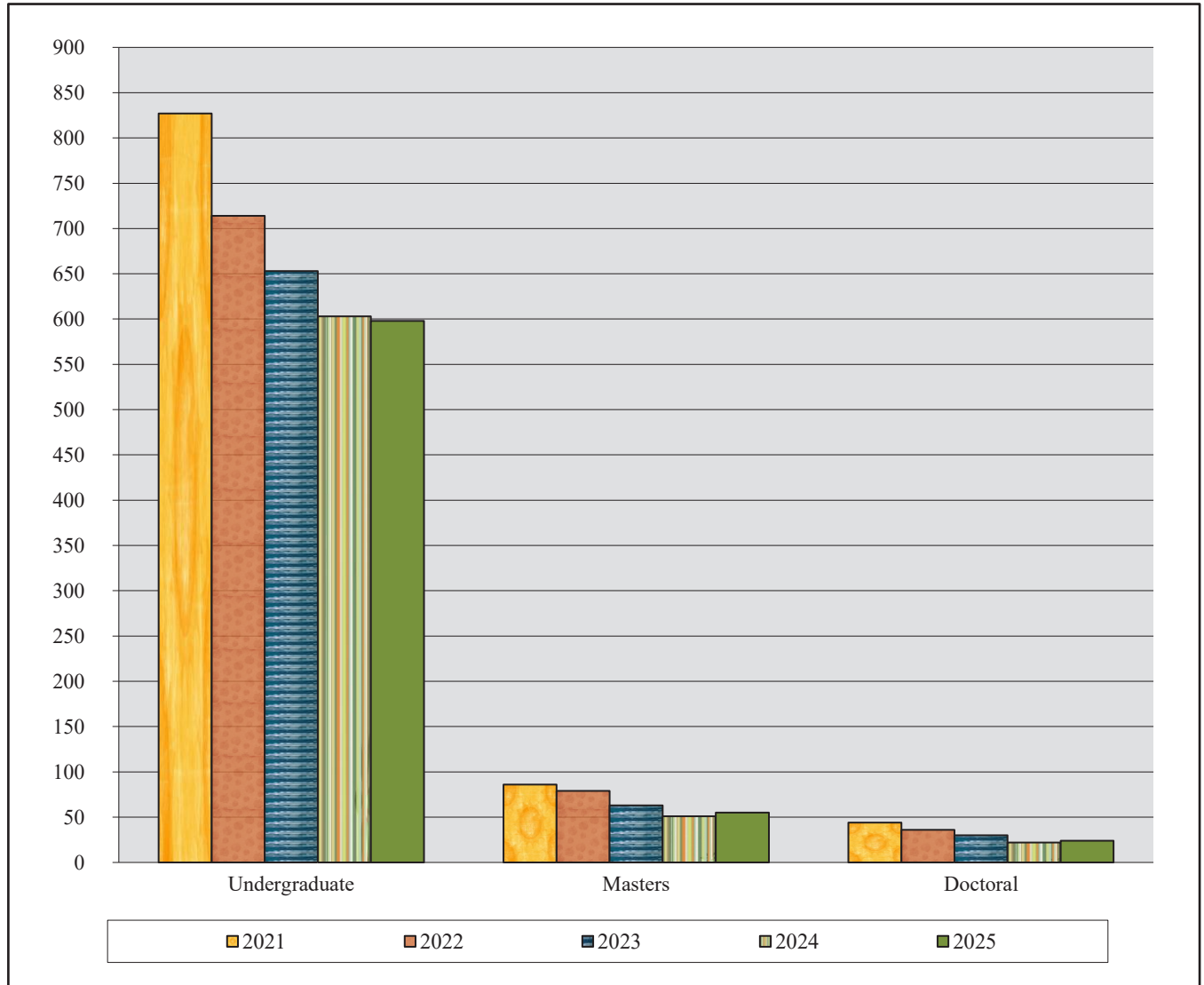

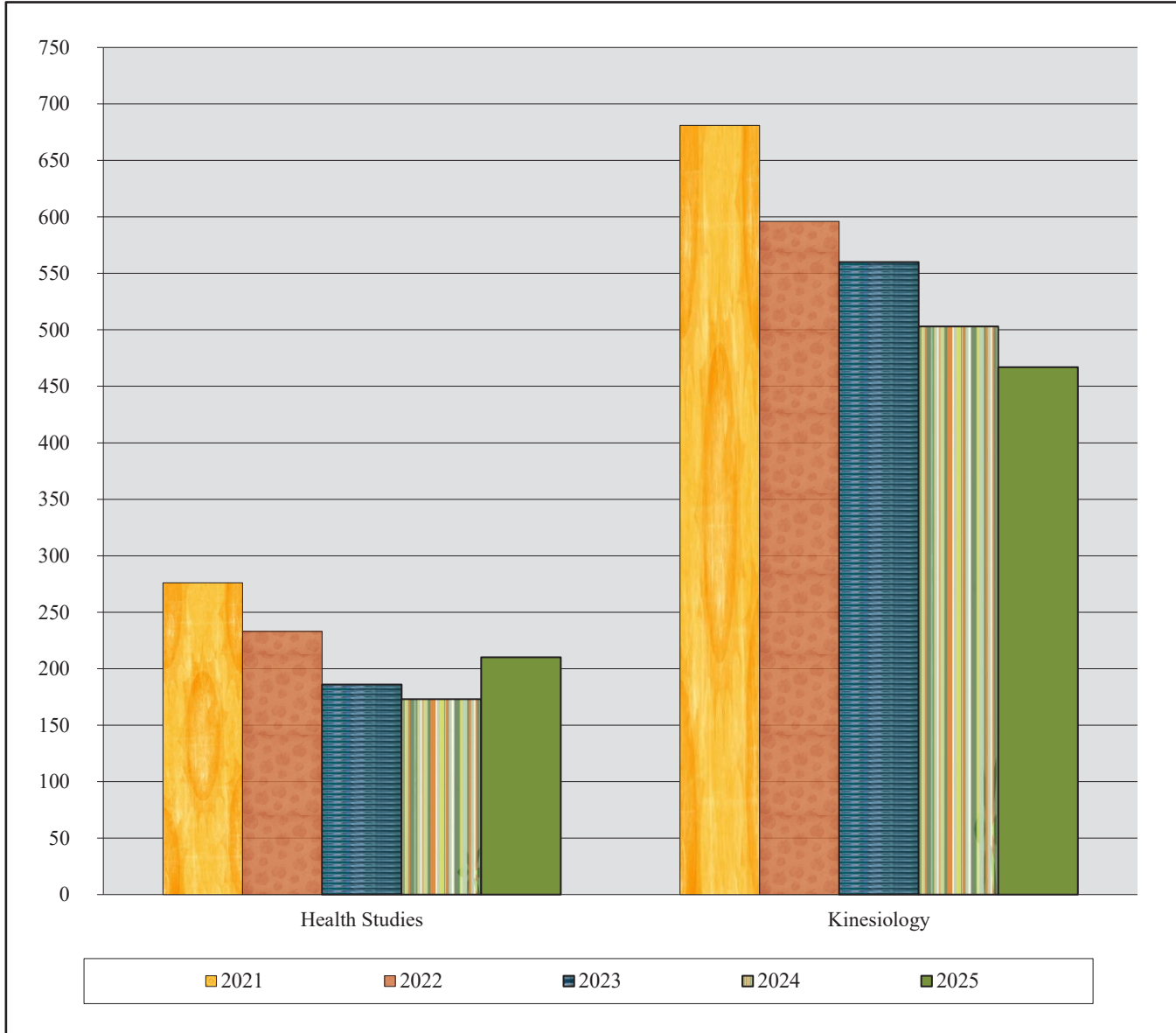

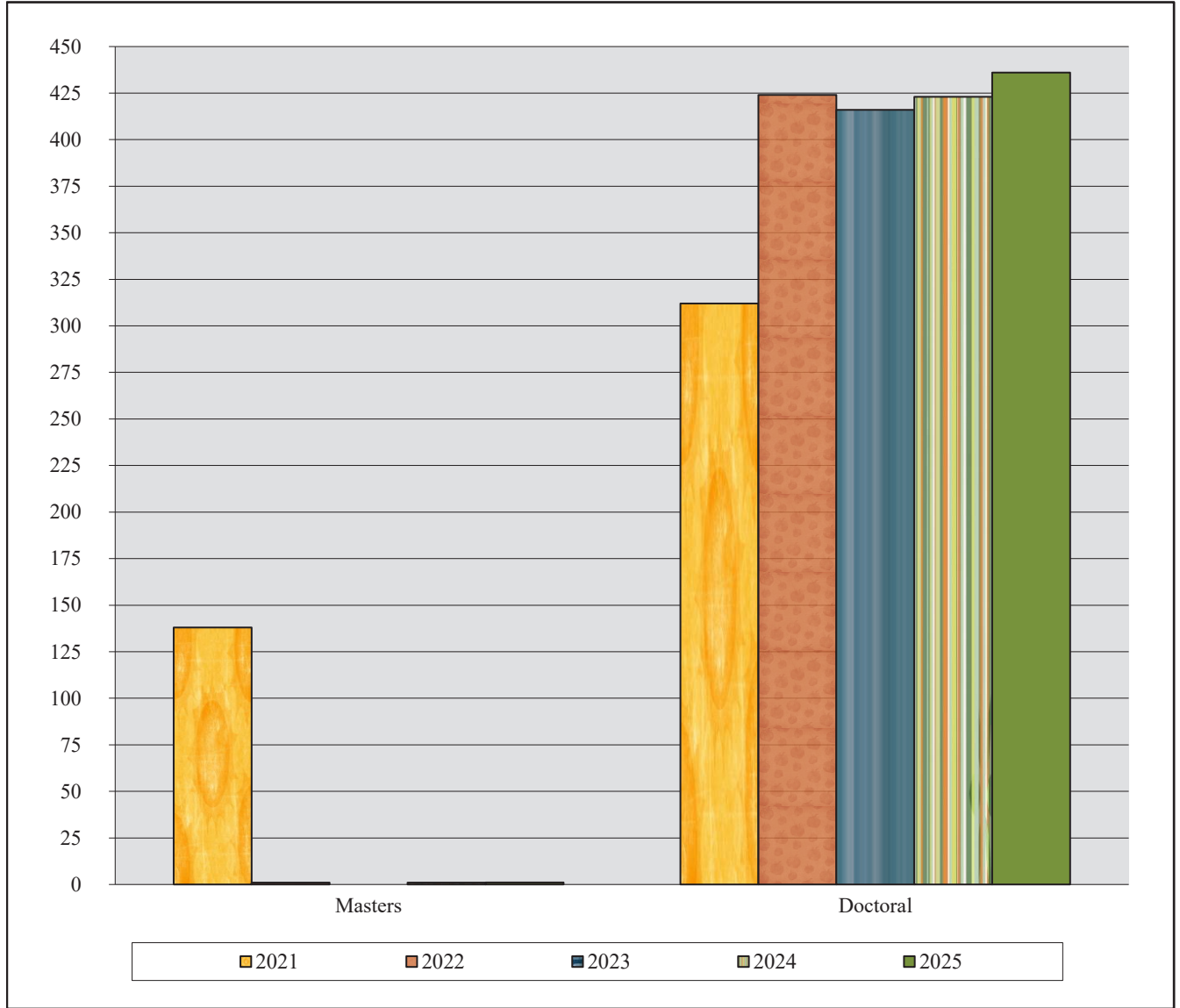

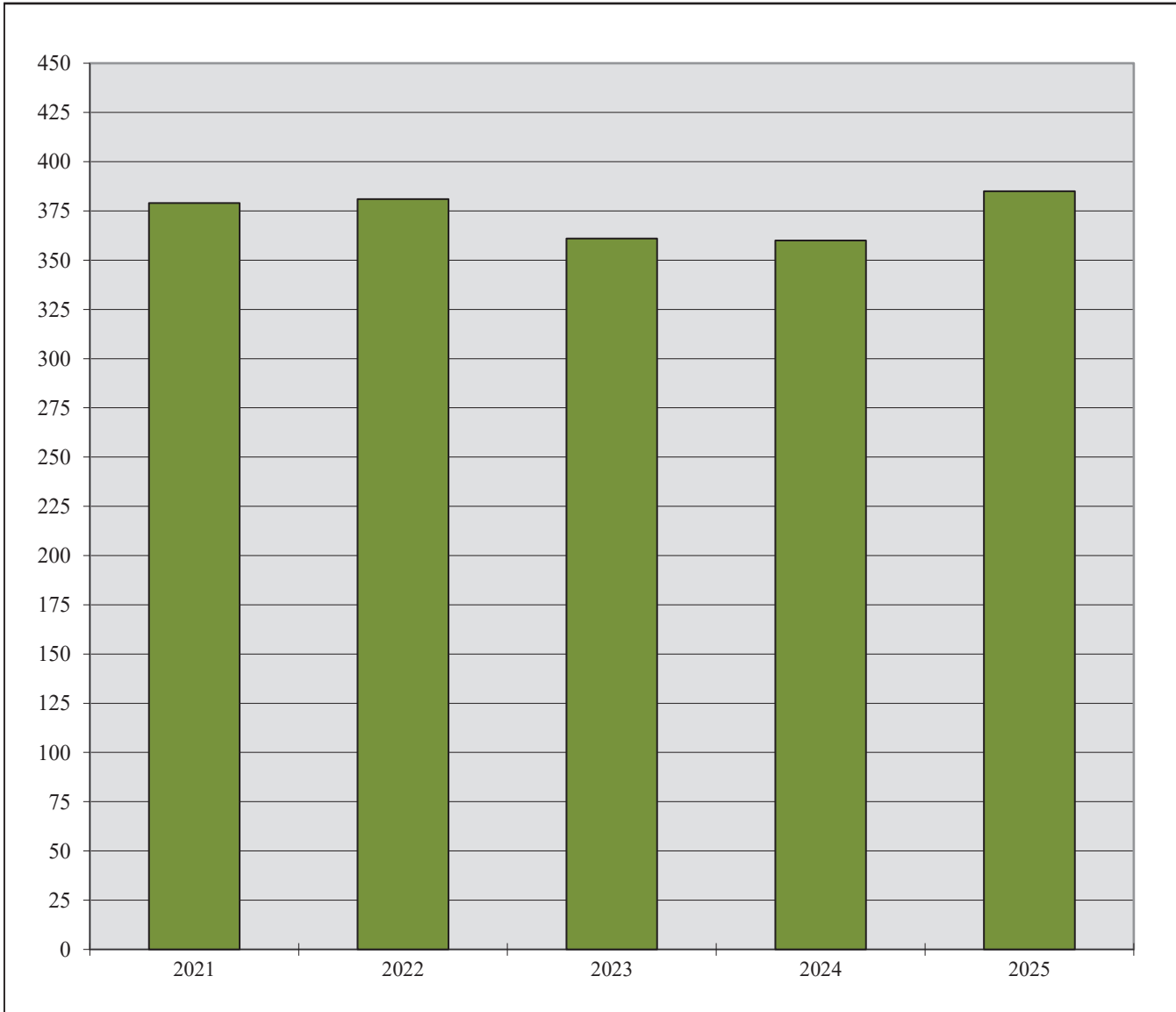

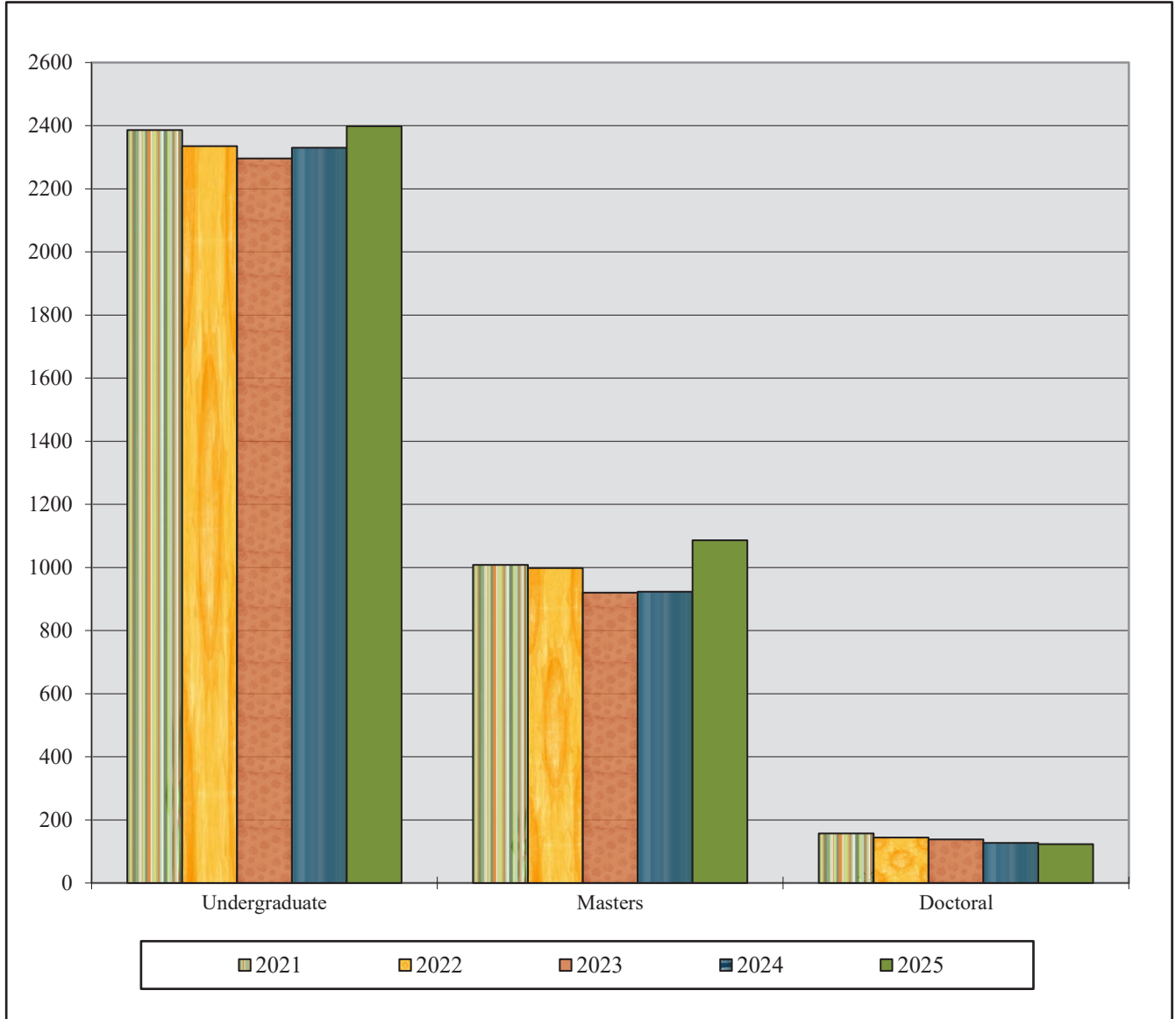

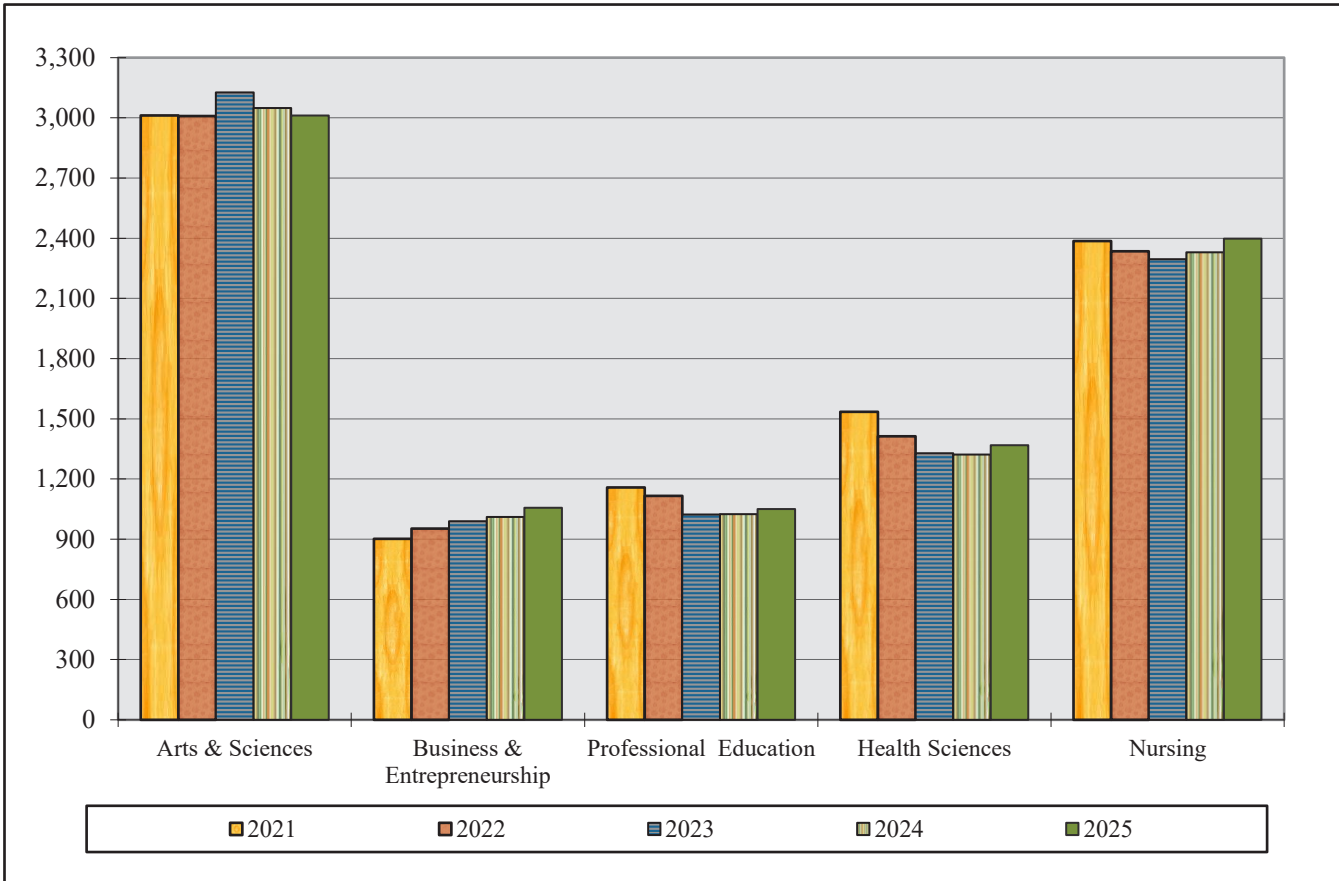

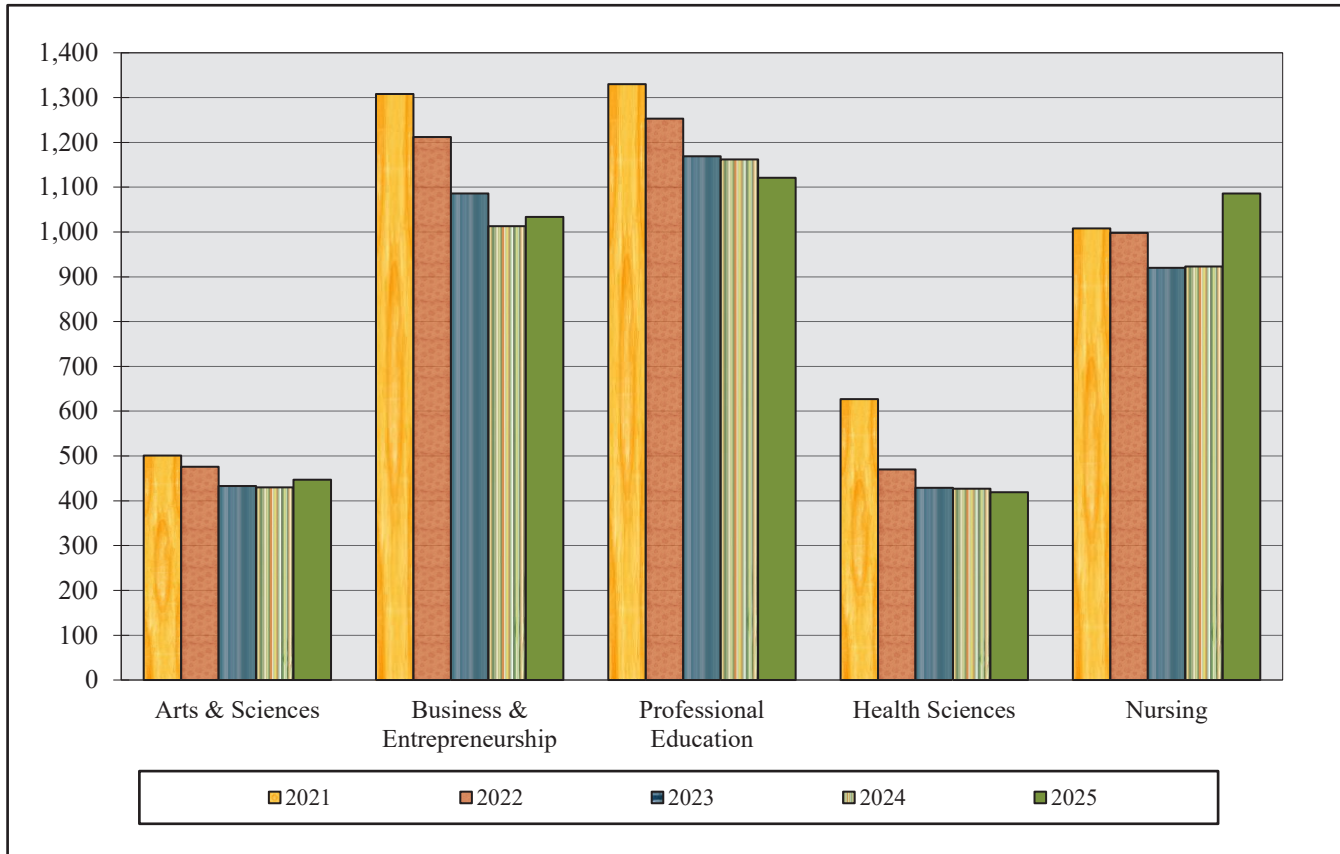

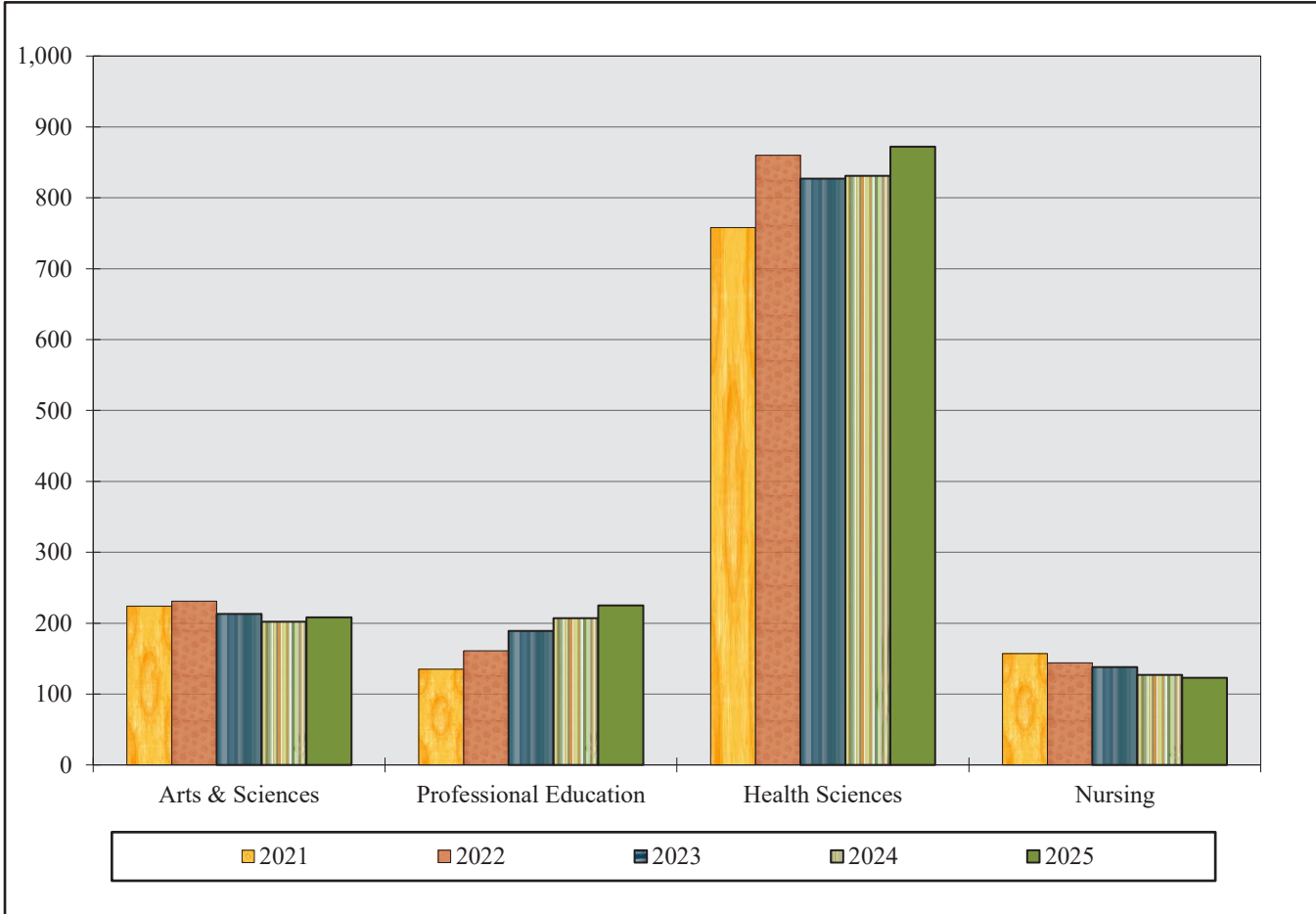
