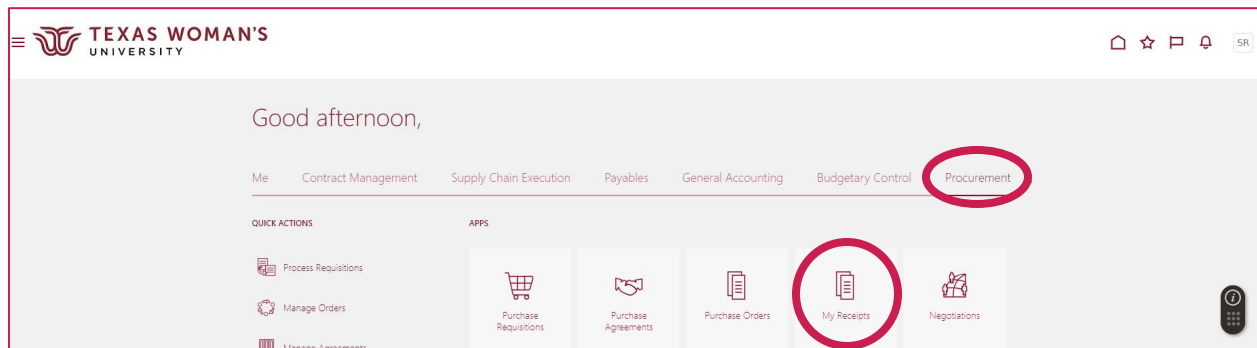
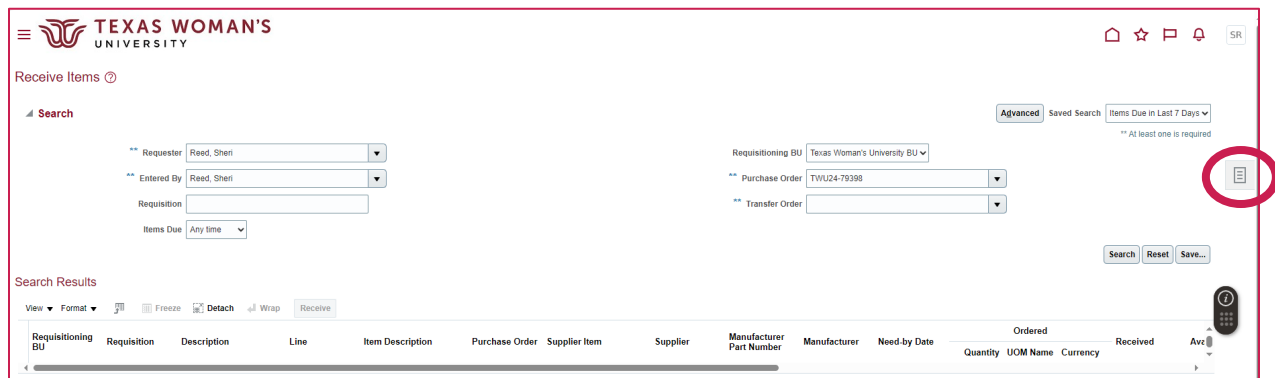


How to Correct a Receipt in Oracle Cloud
